FORM

▣ POSITIVE

I / you / we / they / she / he / it stop**ped** (*II форма глагола*)

▣ NEGATIVE

I / you / we / they / she / he / it **did not (didn't)** stop

(*I форма глагола*)

▣ QUESTIONS

Did I / you / we / they / she / he / it stop?

*When **did** he/she... stop?*

*Why **did** he/she... stop?*

SPELLING RULES

- Глаголы, оканчивающиеся на *-e*, прибавляют *-d*:
decide → decided
- Односложные слова, заканчивающиеся на гласный + согласный, удваивают согласный и прибавляют *-ed*:
stop → stop**ped**
- Остальные глаголы прибавляют *-ed*:
wait → wait**ed**
- Глаголы, оканчивающиеся на гласный + согласный + *-y*, меняют *-y* на *-i* и прибавляют *-ed*:
study → stud**ied**
- *Примечание: -y → -ed: play - play**ed***



SPELLING RULES (CONTINUED)

- Двухсложные слова, оканчивающиеся на одну гласную + одну согласную, удваивают согласную, если ударение падает на последний слог, и прибавляют *-ed*:

prefer → preferred

- Если ударение падает на первый слог, прибавляется *-ed*:

profit → profited



USE

□ Указание на простое действие в прошлом:

I **saw** Michael in the bank

We **went** to a restaurant yesterday evening

□ Регулярные, повторяющиеся действия в прошлом:

The old man often **visited** me

Leonardo **painted** in his studio every day

□ Перечисление последовательности действий в прошлом:

I **heard** a strange sound, **looked** back, and **saw** a huge cat sitting on the table.
