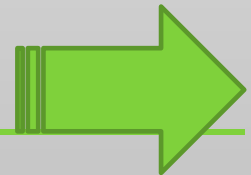

- Created for the millennium celebration, one of the world's largest ferris wheels is a site to behold.



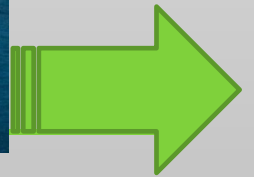
The London Eye

- Built over 900 years ago, it is a historic landmark. Take a guided tour and learn about its many secrets.



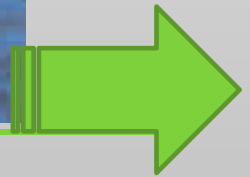
Tower of London



- Experience the city by water. Many of London's attractions are visible from the cruise.



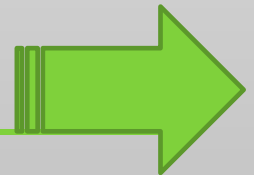
The Thames River cruise



- A famous square in central London. At the center is Nelson Square, surrounded by fountains.



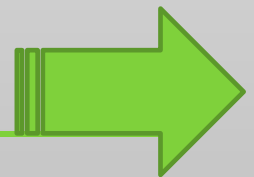
Trafalgar Square



The seat of the bishop of London today. Five churches have been built here, with the first one in the 7th century.



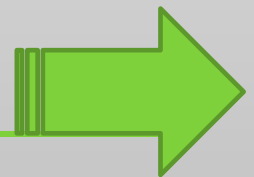
St. Paul's Cathedral
