-Do you go to night clubs?

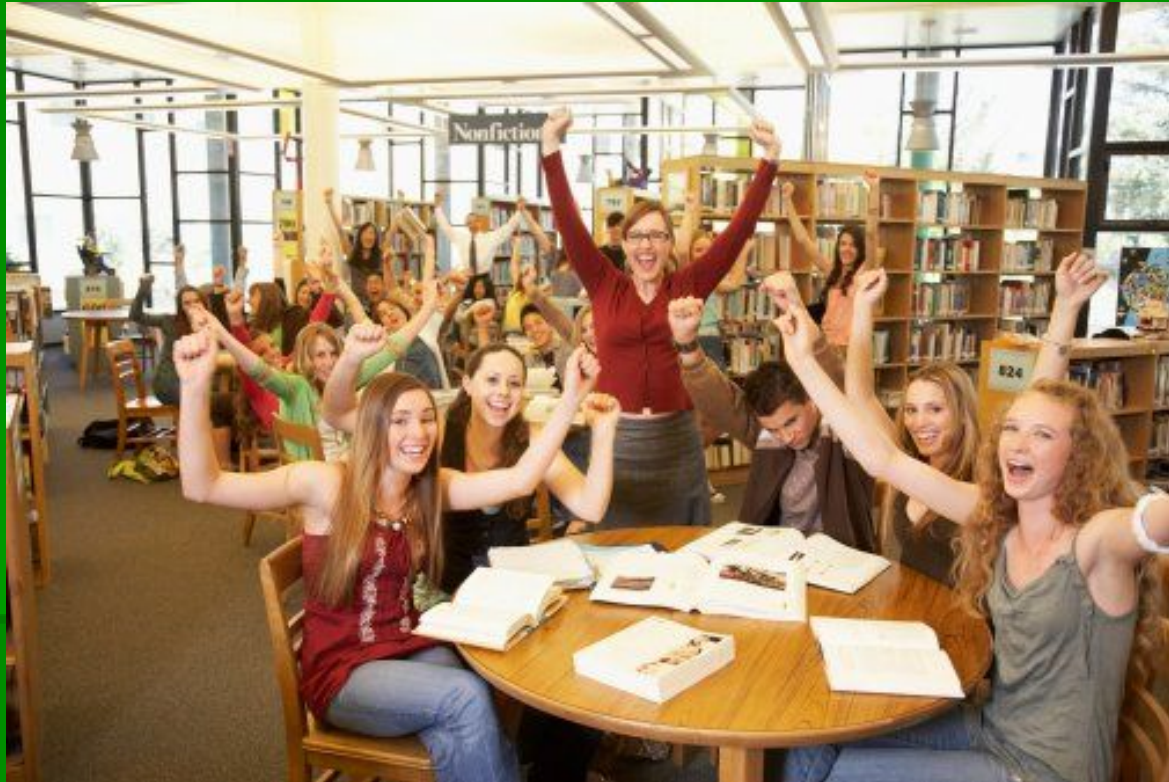
