History

- Creation 1534
 - Branches appeared
- Attempts at Reunification
 - Queen Mary
 - mid-19th century Oxford Movement
 - Vatican II, hopes for the prospect of reunification rose again
 - Even now some movements aimed at reuniting the Church of England with Rome



Similarities

- The relationship between Anglicanism and Roman Catholicism has always been different from the other Catholic-Protestant divides
- Do not really dispute over some meaningful theological matters
- Even after the split, the Church of England maintained a hierarchy with bishops and priests – Apostolic succession





Apostolic succession

• Apostolic succession, in Christianity, the principal according to which bishops represent a direct, uninterrupted line of continuity from the Apostles of Jesus Christ.

Differences with Catholicism

- The head of the Church of England– the Monarch
- "Sola Scriptura" rely only on Bible
- Interpret The Holy Scripture freely
