# History

- Creation – 1534
  - Branches appeared
- Attempts at Reunification
  - Queen Mary
  - mid-19th century - Oxford Movement
  - Vatican II, hopes for the prospect of reunification rose again
  - Even now some movements aimed at reuniting the Church of England with Rome



# Similarities

- The relationship between Anglicanism and Roman Catholicism has always been different from the other Catholic-Protestant divides
- Do not really dispute over some meaningful theological matters
- Even after the split, the Church of England maintained a hierarchy with bishops and priests – Apostolic succession



# Apostolic succession

Апостольская преемственность

- **Apostolic succession**, in Christianity, the principal according to which bishops represent a direct, uninterrupted line of continuity from the **Apostles** of Jesus Christ.

# Differences with Catholicism

- The head of the Church of England– the Monarch
- “*Sola Scriptura*” – rely only on Bible
- Interpret The Holy Scripture freely
