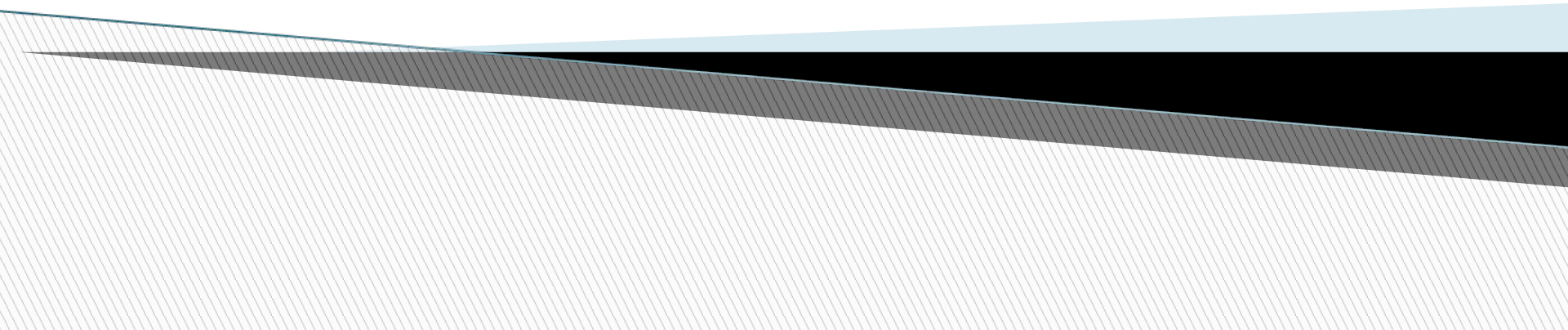


Effective Lesson Planning




‘Good Lesson Planning is the art of mixing techniques, activities and materials in such a way an ideal balance is created for the class.’

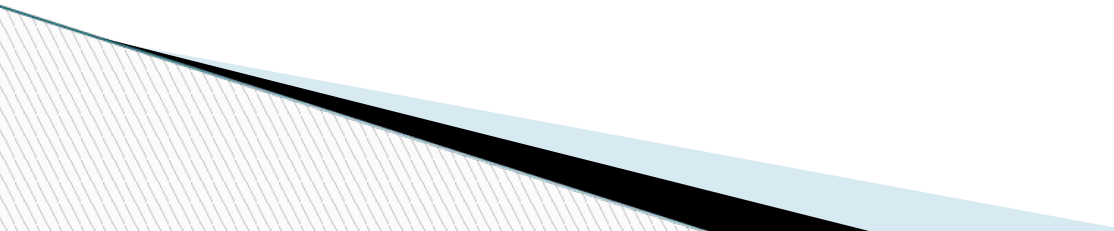
