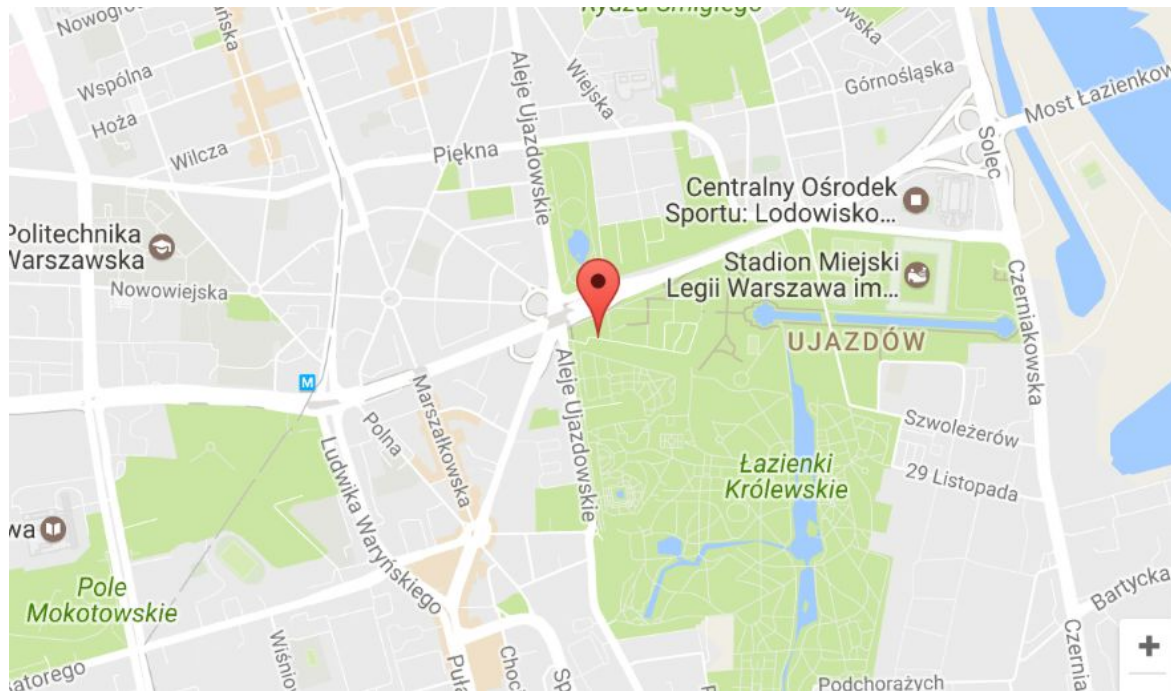
Łazienki Królewskie Museum
