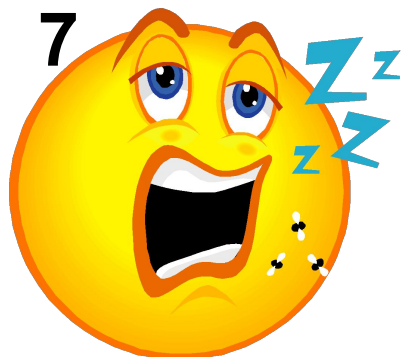
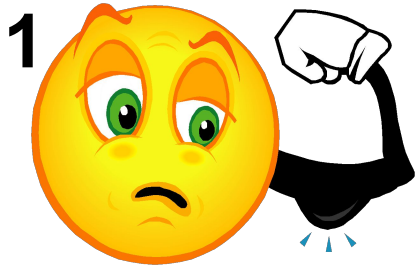

Boring or Bored?
