Ludwig van Beethoven was born in December 1770 in Bonn. The exact date of birth is not established, known only to the date of Baptism – December 17. His father, Johann

(Johann van Beethoven,) was a singer, a tenor, in the court chapel, the mother of Mary Magdalene, before her marriage Reverih (Maria Magdalena Reverich, ), the court was the daughter of a chel in Koblenz then



The father of the composer wanted to make a second son of Mozart, and began to teach the game on the harpsichord and violin. In 1778 in Cologne hosted the first performance of the boy. However, the miracle baby Beethoven did not. the father of the



In 1780, in Bonn came organist and composer Christian Gottlob Nave. He became the teacher of Beethoven. Nave immediately realized that the boy's talent. He acquainted with Ludwig's "Well-Tempered Clavier" by Bach and Handel's works, as well as with music older

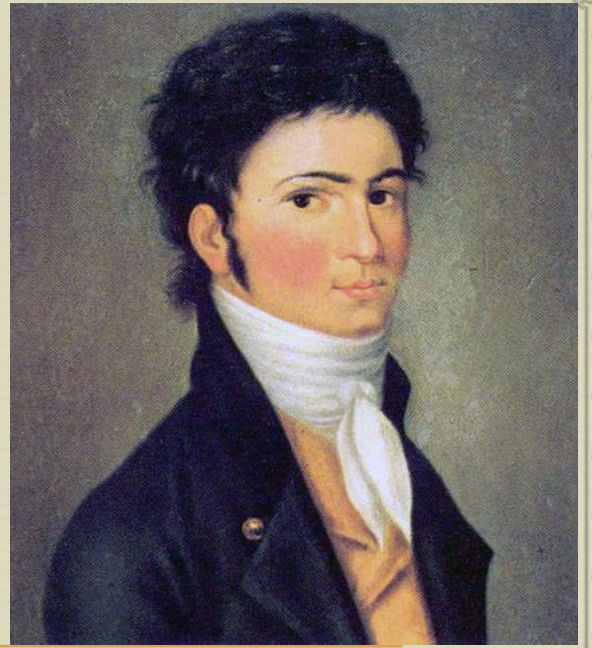

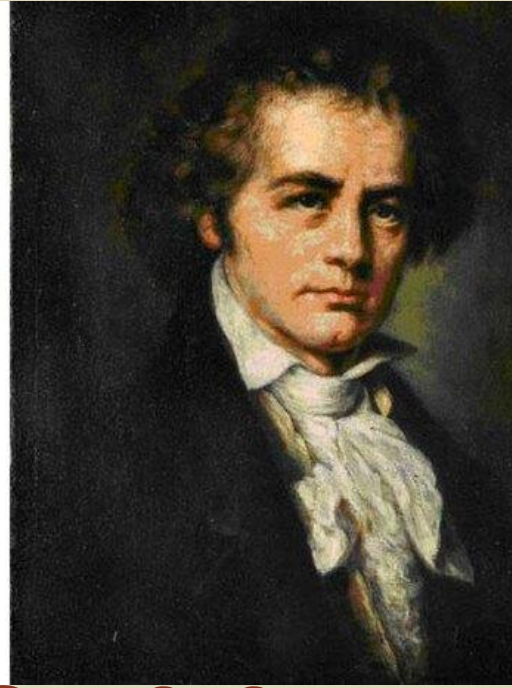

When Beethoven was 34 years old, Napoleon abandoned the ideals of the French Revolution and declared himself emperor. So Beethoven renounced his intention to devote his Third Symphony:

"This Napoleon, too, an ordinary man. Now he will trample underfoot all human rights, and become a tyrant."

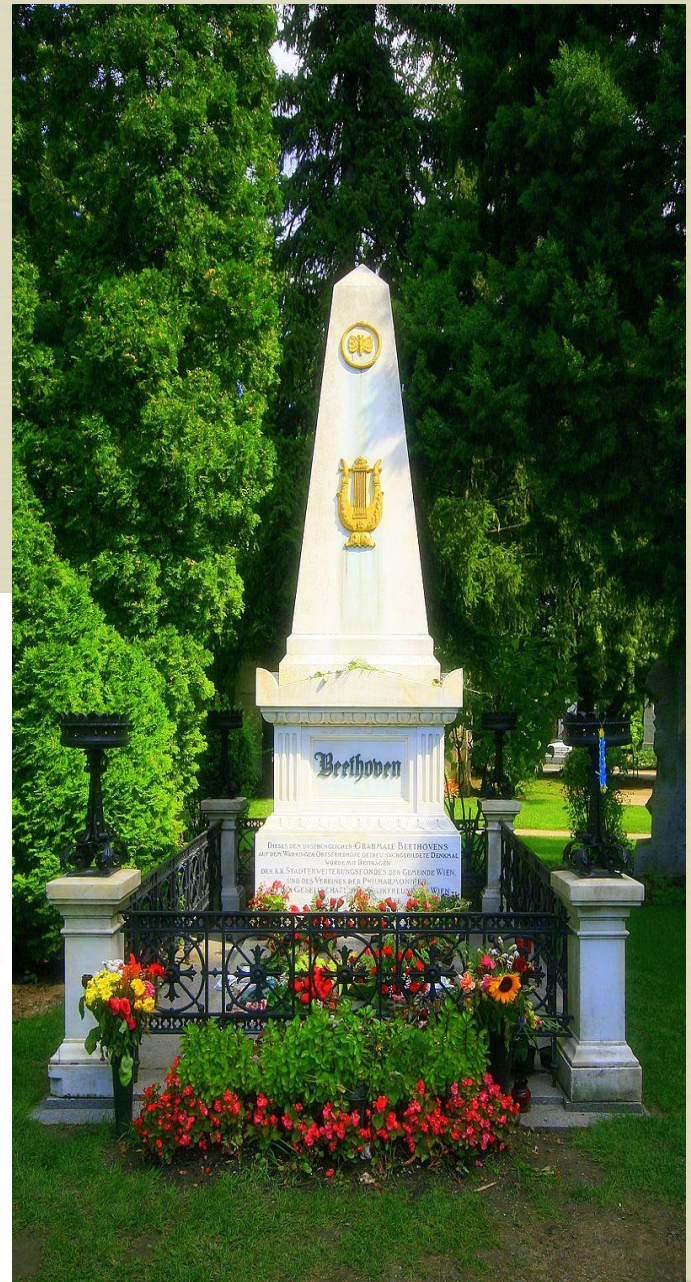

Death March 26, 1827 at  
the age of 57 Beethoven  
died. It is unknown, but  
U.S. researchers,  
examining hair and  
skull fragments of  
Ludwig van Beethoven,  
came to the conclusion  
that the great German  
composer, probably died  
of a long lead poisoning.
