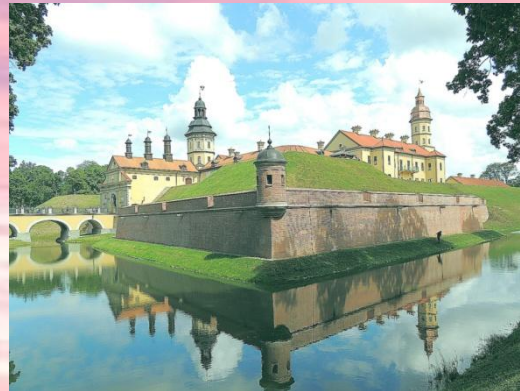

In 1992 was introduced the Belarusian ruble, began forming their own armed forces, was legalized the Belarusian Greek Catholic Church. In 1993, Belarus ratified the international Covenant on civil and political rights.***
