

ankle (n): the joint where your foot joins your leg (лодыжка (сущ): сустав, где ступня присоединяется к вашей ноге Запиши в рабочую тетрадь.





Reflexive Pronouns

Возвратные местоимения

English reflexive pronouns end in -self' or -selves and are used when the subject of the verb and the direct object of the verb are the same person.



Возвратные местоимения употребляются, когда подлежащее и дополнение являются одним лицом.
