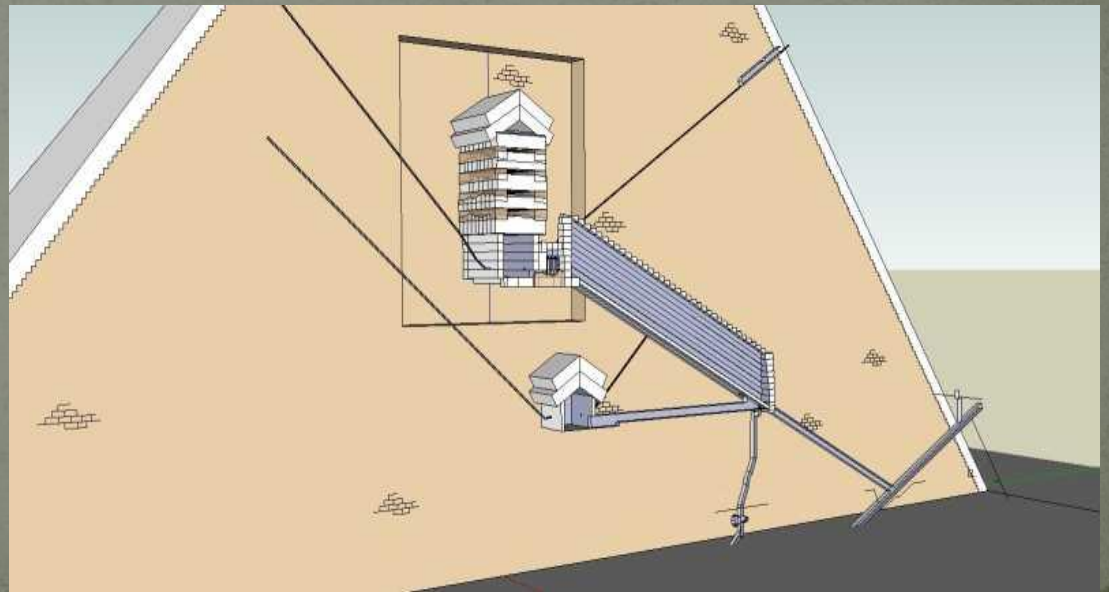
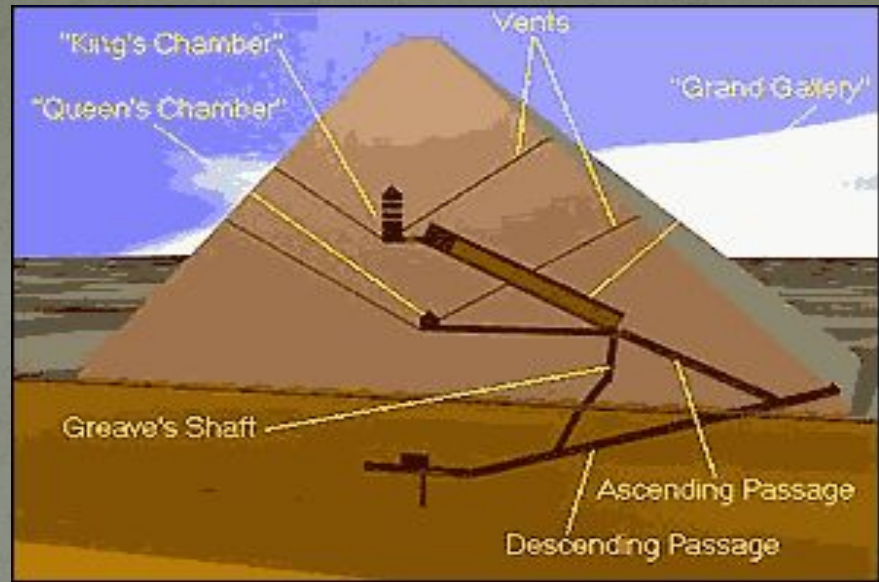
Egyptian pyramids - the greatest architectural monuments of ancient Egypt.

Pyramids are a huge pyramid-shaped stone structures that were used as tombs for pharaohs of ancient Egypt.

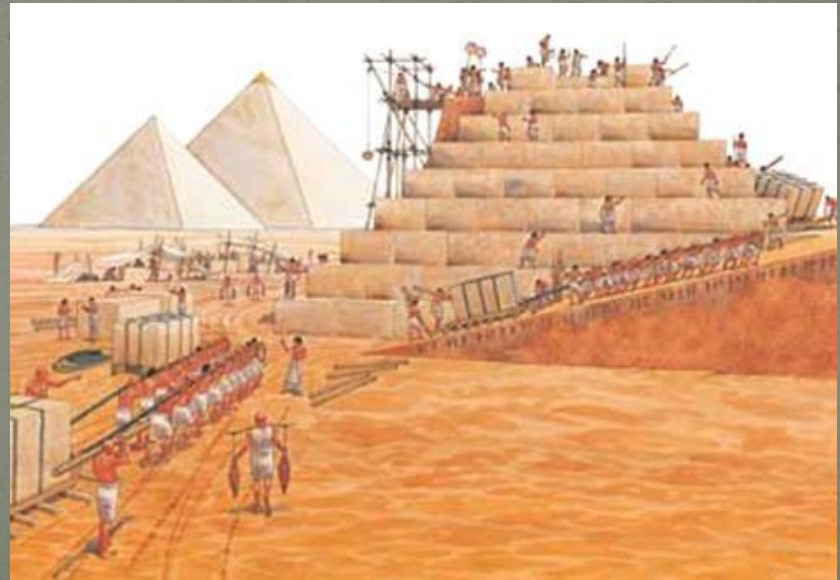


Pyramid of Cheops Great Pyramid of Giza

The architect of the Great Pyramid is considered Hemion, Vizier and nephew of Cheops. He also held the title of "Managing all construction projects of the pharaoh." More than three thousand years the pyramid is the tallest building in the world.

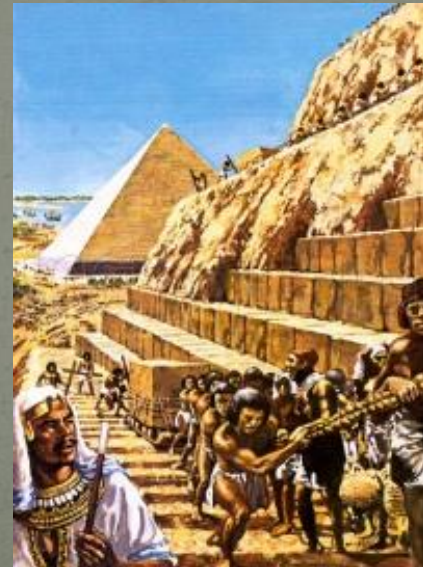

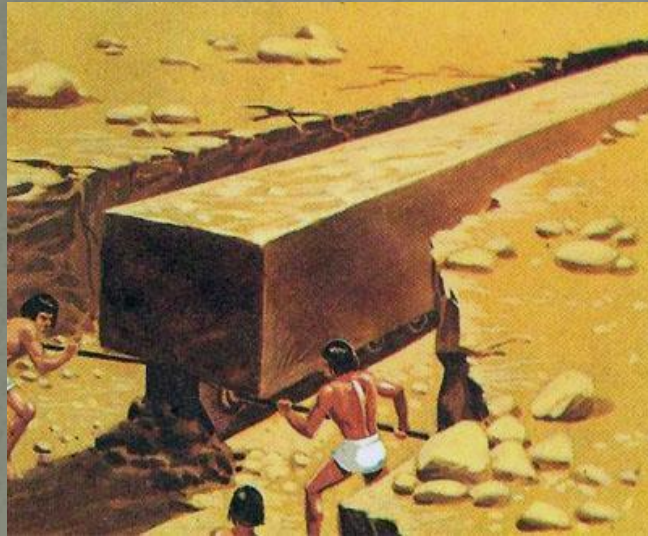
There are many hypotheses about the Egyptian pyramid construction techniques.
