# NEVER USE/DO

- Personal phrases (I/we can see, You may notice, Do you understand?, If I'm right...)
- Personal opinion
- Speculations/predictions
- Distract from the topic
- Use colloquial language(informal)
- One word more than once

# ALWAYS DO/USE

- Paraphrase the topic fully but precisely
- Elicit the main trend of the diagram
- Mention only the main details
- Academic vocabulary
- Range of vocabulary
- Stick to the topic
