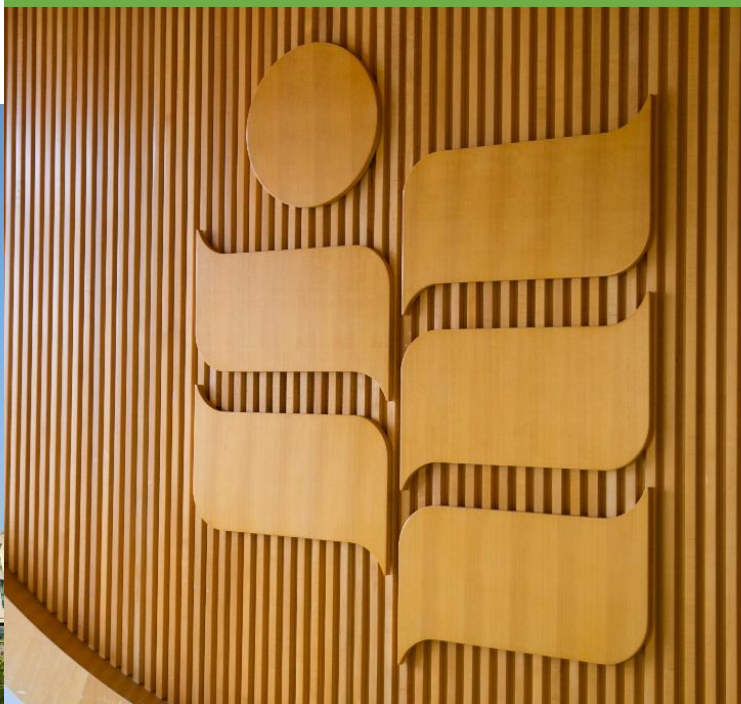

Kazakhstan	Completion of Certificate of Secondary Education (<i>Attestat / Svidetel' stvo o Srednem Obrazovanil</i>) with grade 4 in each of the subjects
IB Diploma	Completion of the IB Diploma
SAT Reasoning Test	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A minimum total score of 1,190 (out of 1,600) in the new SAT Reasoning Test (including Evidence-Based Reading and Writing, and Mathematics); or - 1,650 (out of 2,400) in the old SAT Reasoning Test (including Critical Reading, Writing, and Mathematics) in one sitting
GCE A-level / International Advanced Level (IAL)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Grade E or above in 3 AL (or A2) subjects (other than Chinese/ Mandarin/ English); or - Grade E in 2 AL (or A2) plus 2 Advanced Supplementary (AS) subjects (other than Chinese/ Mandarin/ English) <p>(The same subject cannot be counted at both the A-level and AS-level)</p>

Admission Requirements – English Language

IELTS Academic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A minimum overall band of 6.0
IB Diploma	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Grade 4 or better in the Higher Level English Language (B Syllabus); or - Grade 5 or better in the Standard Level English Language (B Syllabus); or - Grade 4 or better in the Higher or Standard Level English Language (A1 or A2 Syllabus); or - Grade 4 or better in the Higher or Standard Level English A: Language and Literature; or - Grade 4 or better in the Higher or Standard Level English A: Literature; or - Grade 4 or better in the Standard Level English – Literature and Performance; or - Grade 4 or better in the Standard Level English – Text and Performance
SAT Reasoning Test	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A minimum score of 590 in the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing of the new SAT; or - A sub-score on essay writing of no less than 8 in the old SAT
GCE AS Level or AL Level English	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Grade E or above

Non-local students are not allowed to take up any paid or unpaid employment in Hong Kong during the study period, but there are several exceptions:

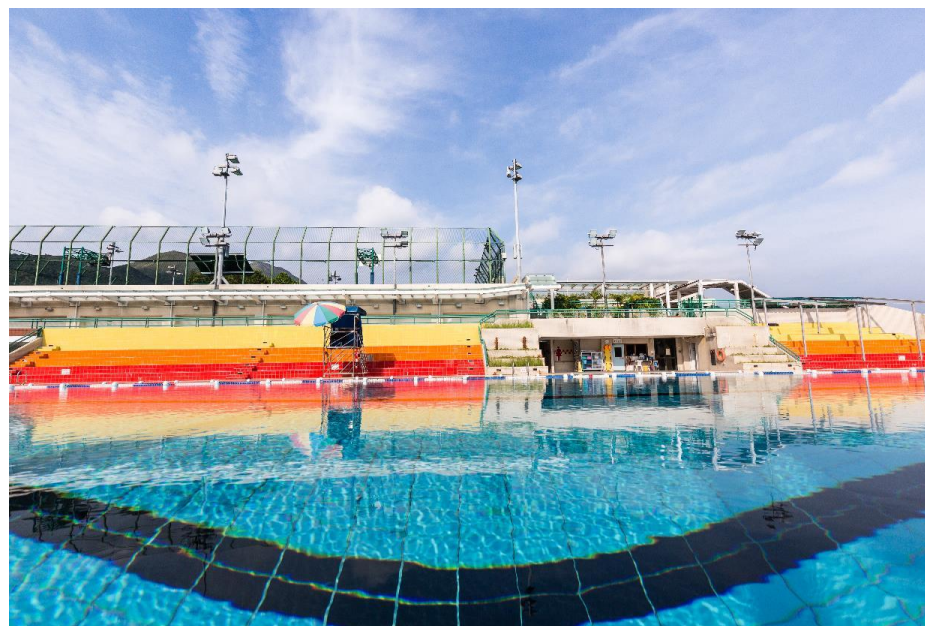
Type of Employment	Period	Work Hours

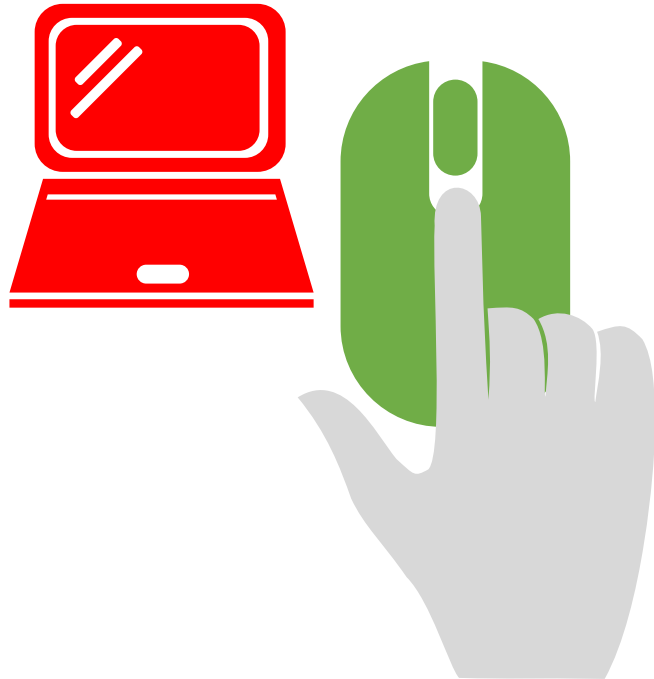
