

SAT Reasoning Test	 A minimum total score of 1,190 (out of 1,600) in the new SAT Reasoning Test (including Evidence-Based Reading and Writing, and Mathematics); or 1,650 (out of 2,400) in the old SAT Reasoning Test (including Critical Reading, Writing, and Mathematics) in one sitting 	
GCE A-level / International Advanced Level (IAL)	 Grade E or above in 3 AL (or A2) subjects (other than Chinese/ Mandarin/ English); or Grade E in 2 AL (or A2) plus 2 Advanced Supplementary (AS) subjects (other the Chinese/ Mandarin/ English) (The same subject cannot be counted at both the A-level and AS-level)

SAT Reasoning Test	 A minimum score of 590 in the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing of the new SAT; or A sub-score on essay writing of no less than 8 in the old SAT

Non-local students are not allowed to take up any paid or unpaid employment in Hong Kong during the study period, but there are several exceptions:


Type of Employment	Period	Work Hours


