Invention is designed to uninterrupted supply power in small towns, as well as individual units can be used that provide small objects, such as weather stations, lighthouses and so on.



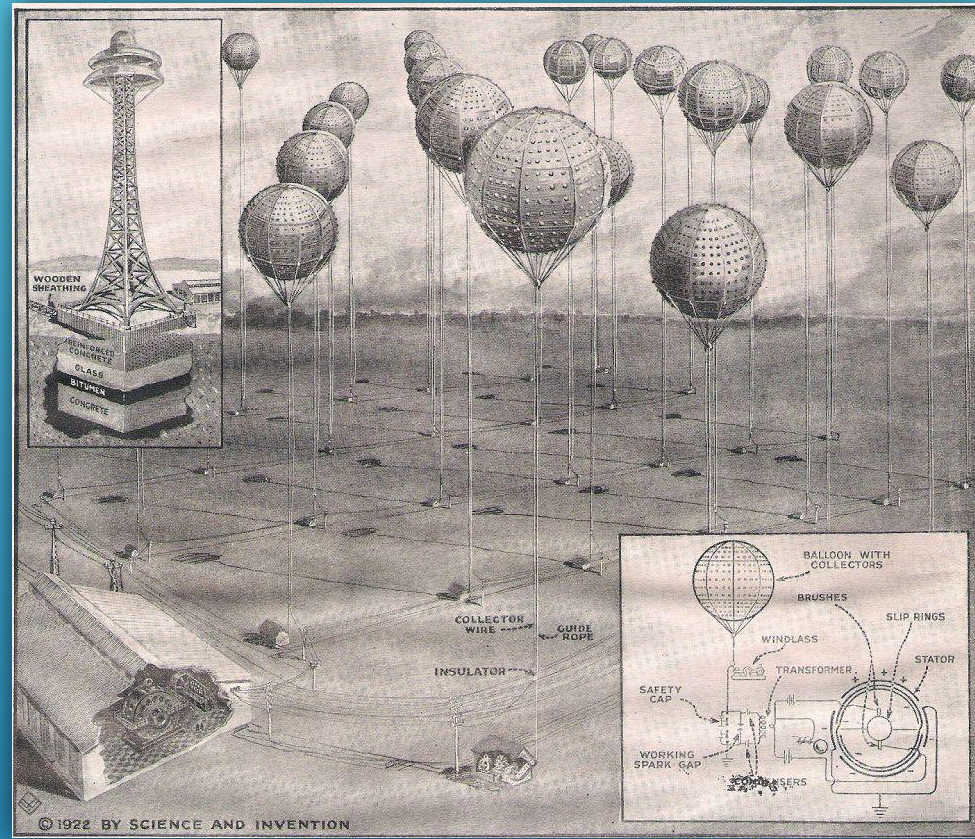

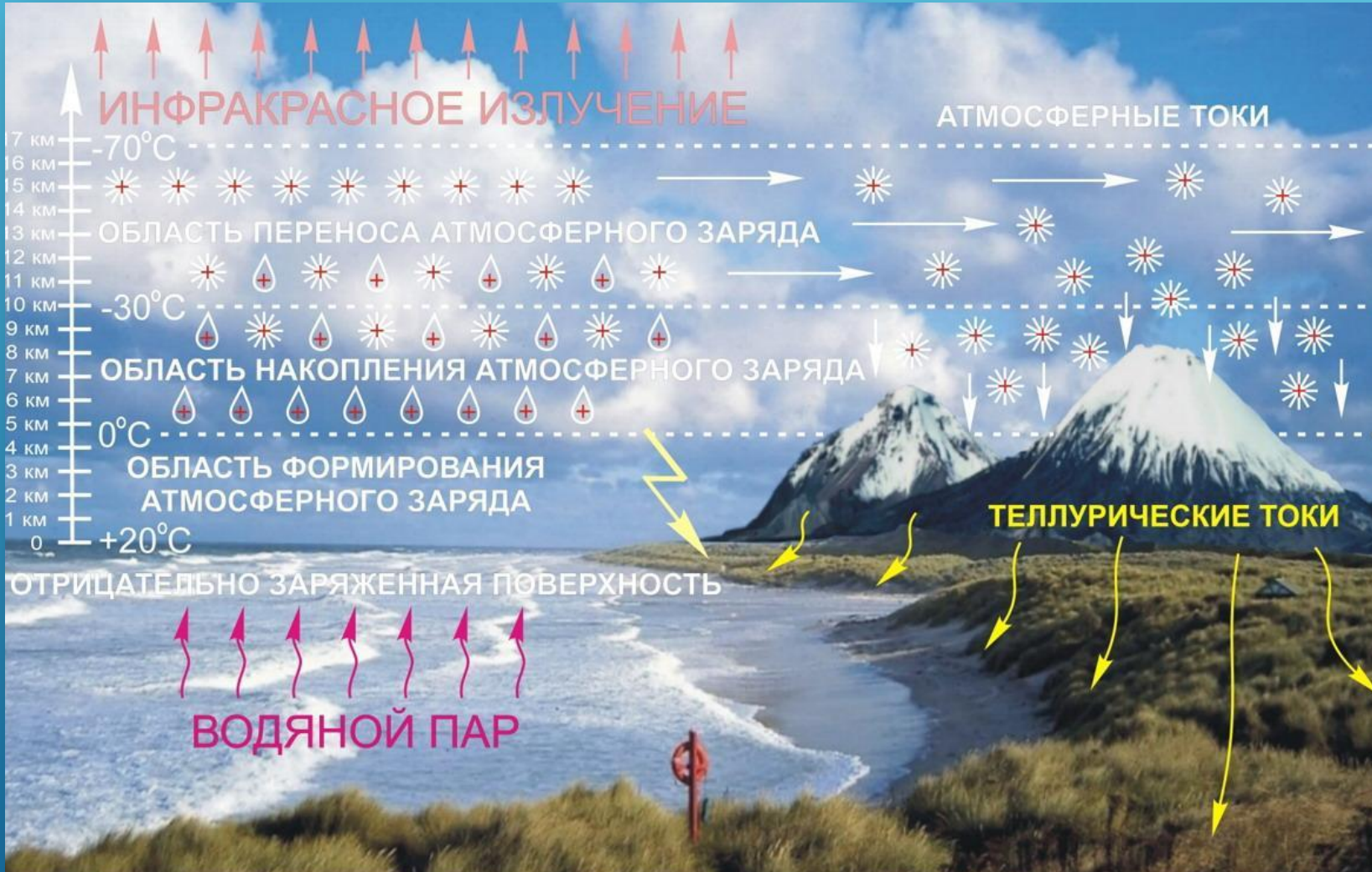

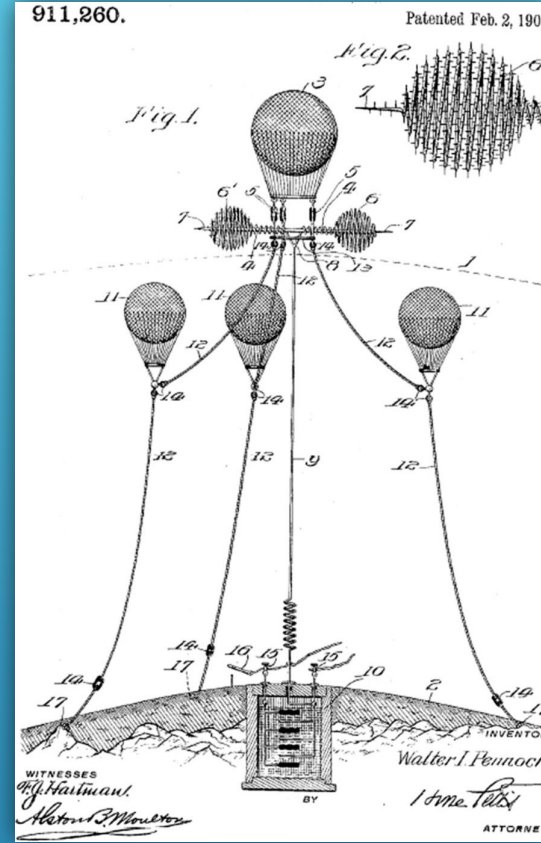




THE STRUCTURE OF THE ATMOSPHERIC INSTALLATION

APPLICATION



Advantages:

- ▶ Low Cost
- ▶ Fast mount and creation
- ▶ Ecological
- ▶ Simple design



Disadvantages:

- ▶ Low power
- ▶ Insecurity
- ▶ Depending on meteorological conditions
