

- **HABITAT:**

eastern Siberia

- **SIZE :**

UP TO 320 kg

- **WHY IN DANGER:**

deforestation, hunting for fur



e.g. Siberian tigers live in eastern Siberia. They are quite big animals. They can weigh up to 320 kilograms. They are endangered species because poachers hunt for their fur and people destroy their habitat. People mustn't hunt for them and destroy their habitat.

- **HABITAT:**

- **SIZE:**

1,700 kilograms**

- **WHY IN DANGER:**

global warming

THE MAGELLANIC PENGUIN



- **HABITAT:**

South America

- **SIZE:**

61–76 cm,

2.7 kg and 6.5 kg

- **WHY IN DANGER:** global warming, illegal hunting

THE LEATHERBACK TURTLE

- **HABITAT:**

**worldwide in the open ocean –
Alaska, Africa, New Zealand**

- **SIZE:**

up to 2.7 meters

- **WHY IN DANGER:**

**destructive fishing,
smuggling eggs**



THE BLUEFIN TUNA

- **HABITAT:**

Atlantic Ocean, Pacific Ocean

- **SIZE:** **2-2.5 metres,**
 150-450 kg

- **WHY IN DANGER:**
 overfishing

Central Africa

- **SIZE:**

1.9 m, 220 kg

- **WHY IN DANGER:**

**illegal hunting,
deforestation**

- **HABITAT:**

**North and Central America,
Australia, New Zealand**

- **SIZE:**

wingspan from 8.9–10.2 cm

- **WHY IN DANGER: deforestation**



THE JAVAN RHINOCEROS

- **HABITAT:**

Java Island, Indonesia

- **SIZE:**

between 900 and 2,300 kg

- **WHY IN DANGER:**

illegal hunting for horns

- **HABITAT:**
**central-western and south western
China**
- **SIZE:**
up to 150 kilograms
- **WHY IN DANGER:**
loss of habitat, low birthrate
