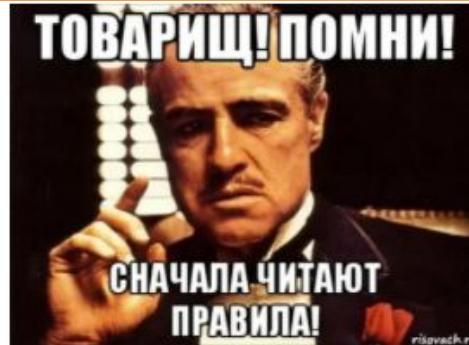

THE INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL RULES & REGULATIONS

STUDENTS MUST KEEP THE PREMISES CLEAN and TIDY!

BEDROOMS

- ▶ You mustn't make noise.
- ▶ You mustn't put posters on the walls.
- ▶ You can't keep pets in the rooms.
- ▶ You can't have parties in your room at any time.

COMMON ROOM

- ▶ You can use the common room but you must get permission to invite friends or have parties.
- ▶ You can decorate the common room but you mustn't move the furniture.
- ▶ You can't use the common room after 21:00 on weekdays.

VISITORS

- ▶ You must always register your overnight guests at the Accommodation Office.
- ▶ Guests can't stay for a period longer than four nights.
- ▶ You can't have overnight guests during the exam period or the study week.

OUTDOOR AREAS

- ▶ You mustn't park your bike in the garden.
- ▶ You must cycle carefully.
- ▶ You can't take your bike inside the School buildings.
- ▶ You mustn't feed the squirrels or the birds.

DINING HALL

- ▶ You mustn't come to the dining room barefoot.
- ▶ You mustn't remove food from the dining room.
