BIG AMOUNT

a) Uncountable - Singular

I have **MUCH** money I have **A LOT OF** information I have **PLENTY OF** time

b) Countable - Plural

I have MANY books I have PLENTY OF houses I have A LOT OF cars I have LOTS OF relatives I have SEVERAL students



SMALL AMOUNT

a) Uncountable - Singular

I have (A) LITTLE money I have ENOUGH money I have SOME money

b) Countable - Plural

I have (A) FEW books I have SOME books
