- ▶ If you bless yourself as you walk thru the church or a chapel, God will bless you too.



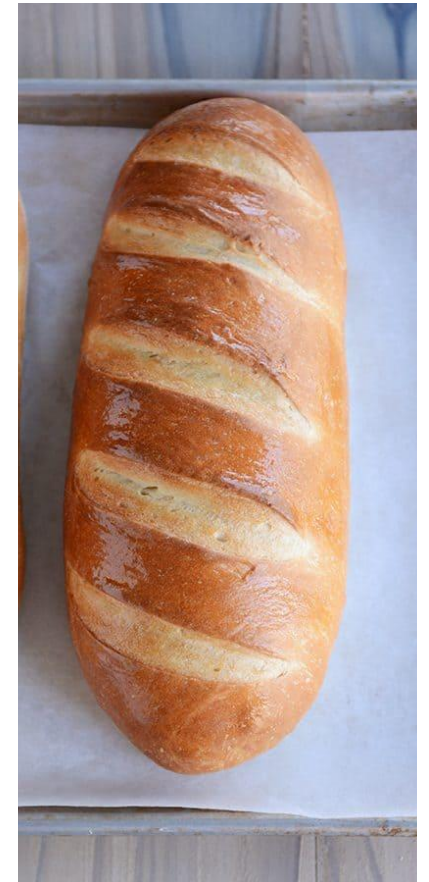
Saturday night
