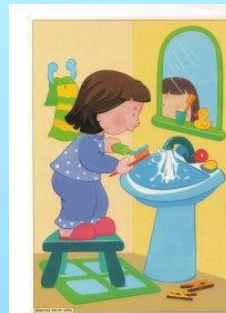

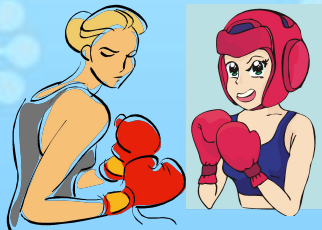
Make up sentences as in the example.
