Aldous Huxley

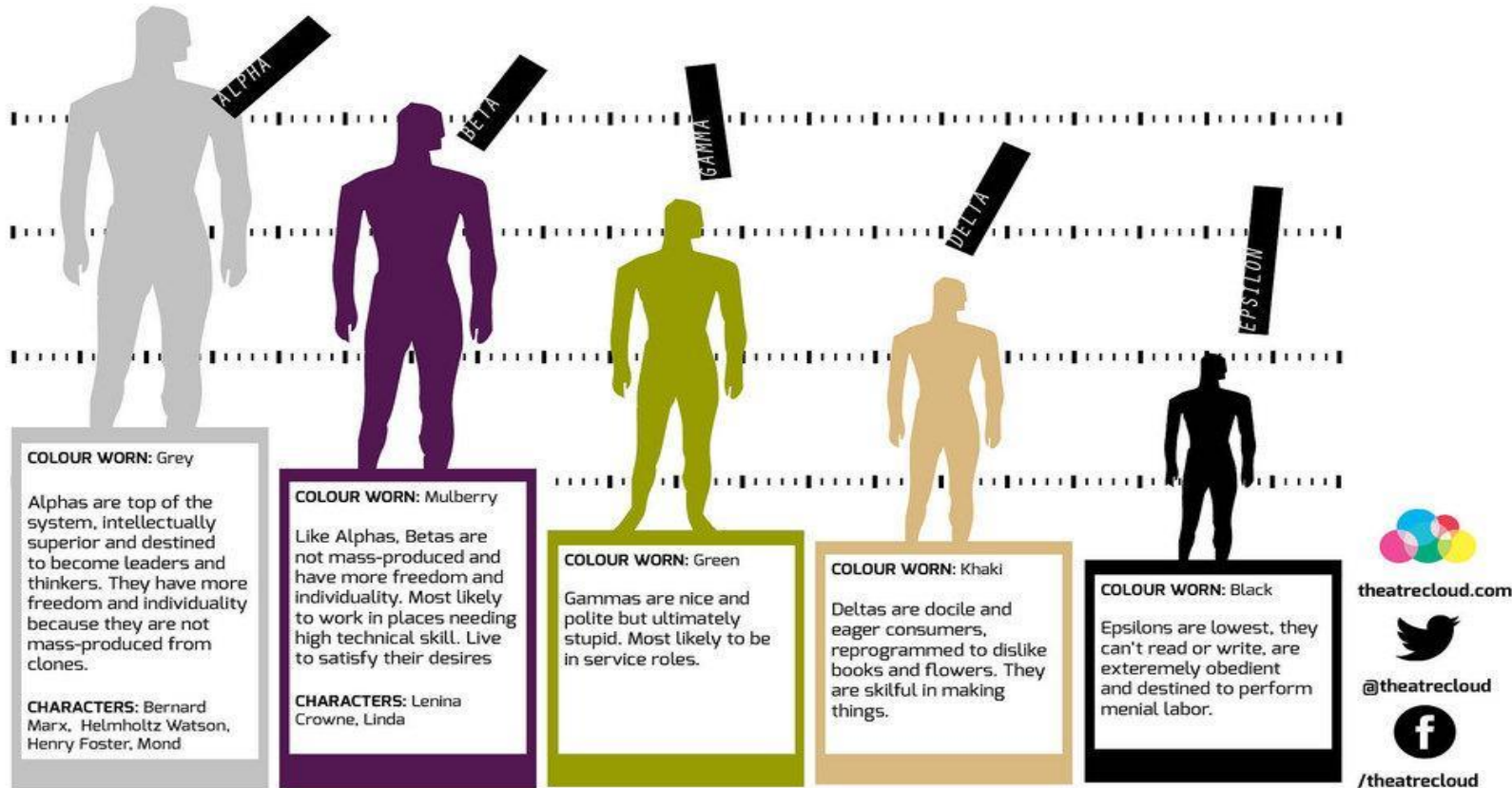
- ❖ Aldous Huxley was born in Surrey, Southern England, in 1894.
- ❖ In 1915 he went to Oxford.
- ❖ Then when World War I broke out he was declared unfit for military.
- ❖ In 1932 he wrote his most famous work "Brave New World".
- ❖ In 1937 he moved to California and in 1963 he died in America.

FIVE CASTE SYSTEMS



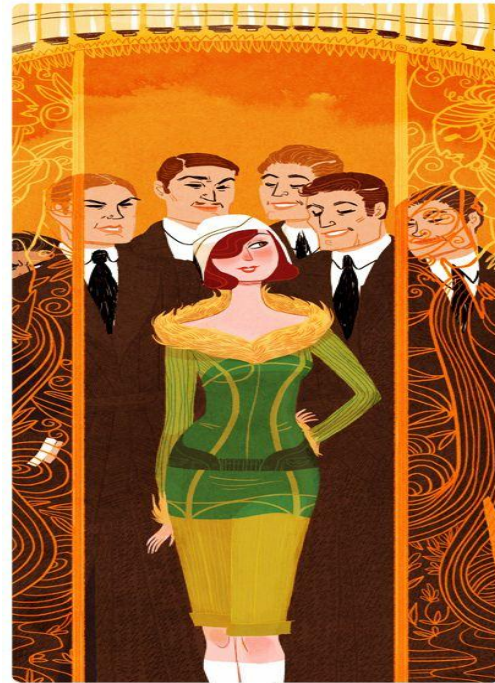

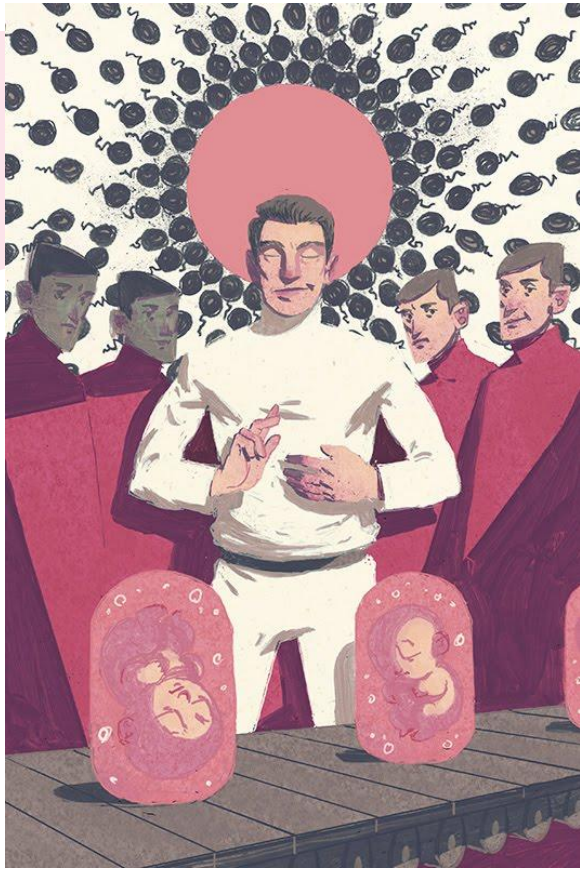
Characters

Bernard Marx, Alpha – psychologist. He dates Lenina for a short time.



Lenina Crowne, Beta – vaccination-worker; an object of desire for a number of major characters.





Helmholtz Watson, Alpha-Plus – lecturer at the College of Emotional Engineering, friend of Bernard Marx and John the Savage.



John the Savage - one of the main protagonists in the story.
