 - They are dirty **now!**

II форма
глагола

Past Simple

- It's used for stories / lists of events in the past.

Past Simple

- We use it to talk about experiences. It is important if we have done it in our lives or not.

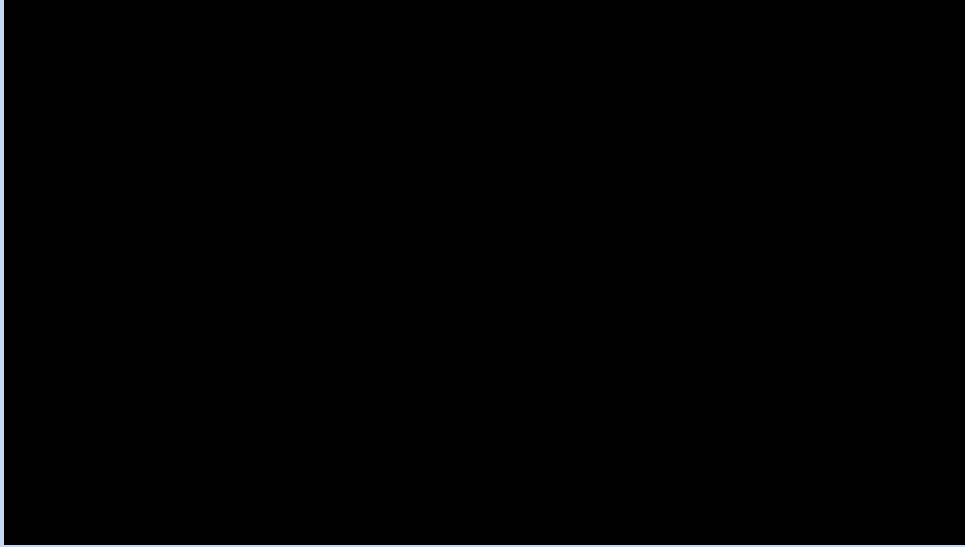
