She won six gold medals of the Europe Championship:

- in 2007, Strasburg
- in 2009, Bukharest
- in 2010, Minsk
- in 2011, Kazan
- in 2012, Antaly
- in 2013, Tirana



She won three gold and one silver medals of the World Championship :

-in 2006, Santo-Domingo

-in 2007, Thailand

-in 2009, Koyan (silver medal)

-in 2011, Paris

And She won the XXVII Summer Universiade in 2013, in Kazan.



In 2008 she became the silver medalist of the Olympic Games in Beijing. But after the disqualification of the Chinese athlete, Oxana Slivenko became the first Olympic Champion in Russia, 9 years later. Now she is waiting for a gold medal.

“Honored Master of Sports
of Russia”

She was awarded the medal
of the order “For Services to
the Fatherland”.
