wedding.

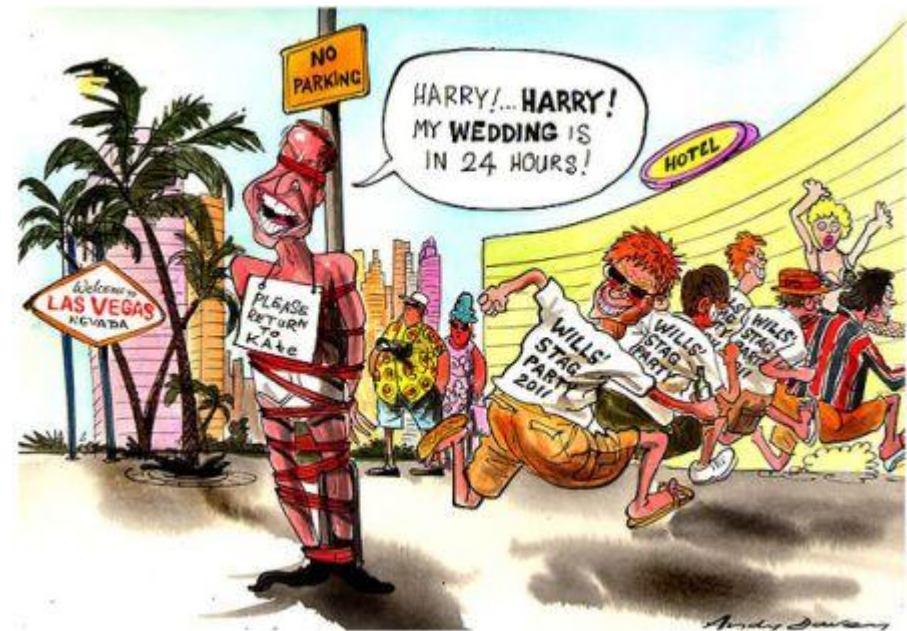

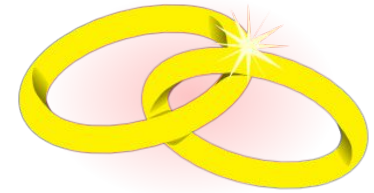

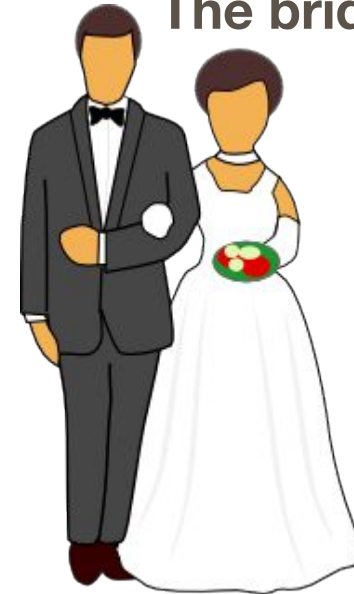

And it is my joy to pronounce you husband and wife. You may now kiss your bride.

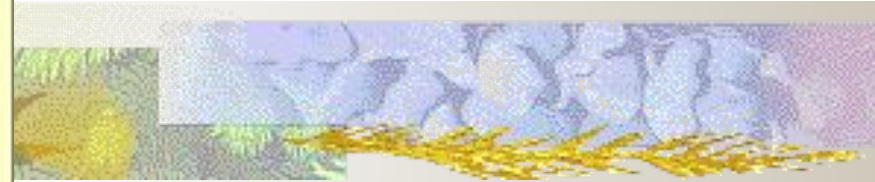

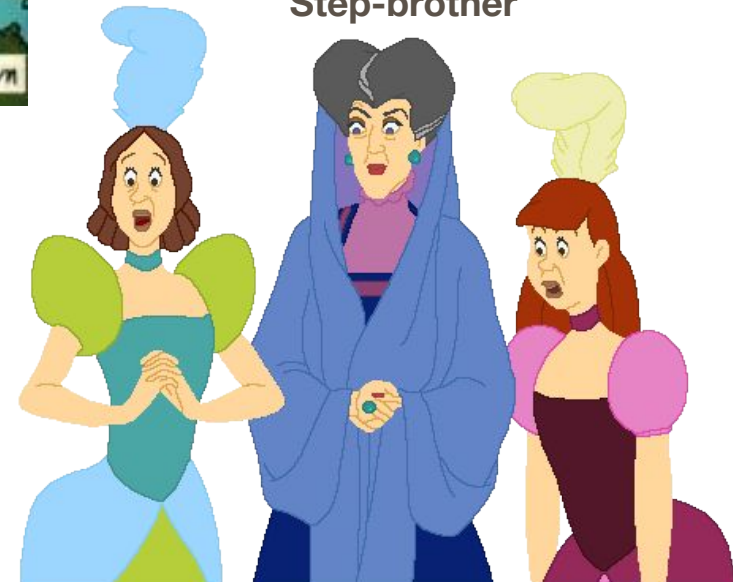
