The flora of Kazakhstan

- * Over six thousand kinds of plants are growing in Kazakhstan
- * 515 of them grow in Kazakhstan only
- * Tulips are believed to first grow on the land of modern Kazakhstan
- * Some of them are rare - *Galanthus*







Fauna of Kazakhstan

- * 500 kinds of birds
- * 178 kinds of animals
- * 49 kinds of reptiles
- * 12 kinds of amphibians
- * and in the rivers and lakes - 107 kinds of fishes
- * A lot of them are in the Red Book of rare species – Snow leopard, Saiga antelope, Steppe eagle, mountain sheep, sand cat, Palas's cat and many more
