

The difference between the following words: *a job, a work, an occupation, a* The *job* is the work the **profession**, *a career.* order to earn money, especially when you work for a company or public organization.

Work is used in a more general way to talk about activities that you do to earn money, either working for a company or for yourself.

We use **occupation** to talk about the kind of work that someone usually does. Occupation is used mainly on official forms.

A **profession** is a kind of work for which you need special training and a good education. Your **career** is the type of work that you do or hope to do for most of your life



took a long time to make up my minds followed in someone's footsteps


followed someone's advice

My Future Profession is Food Technologist



Food Technologist

 The food technologists work in the food and drink industry developing a wide range of products and making sure they are safe for consumers. Food technologist may work on existing and newly-discovered ingredients to invent new recipes and concepts. Technologists modify foods to create products such as fat-free items and ready meals. Some food technologists are involved in conducting experiments and producing sample products, as well as designing the processes and machinery for making products with a consistent flavour, colour and texture in large quantities. Work is usually carried out in factories but may also take place in an office, laboratory or kitchen.

To be a good food technologist you'll need:

- an interest in food production and preparation;
- strong attention to detail;
- the ability to work with strict health and hygiene rules;
- good communication skills, to explain ideas to other scientists and factory staff;

- -provide accurate nutritional information for food labelling;
- -investigate ways to keep food fresh, safe and attractive;
- -find ways of producing food more quickly and cheaply;
- -test the safety and quality of food
