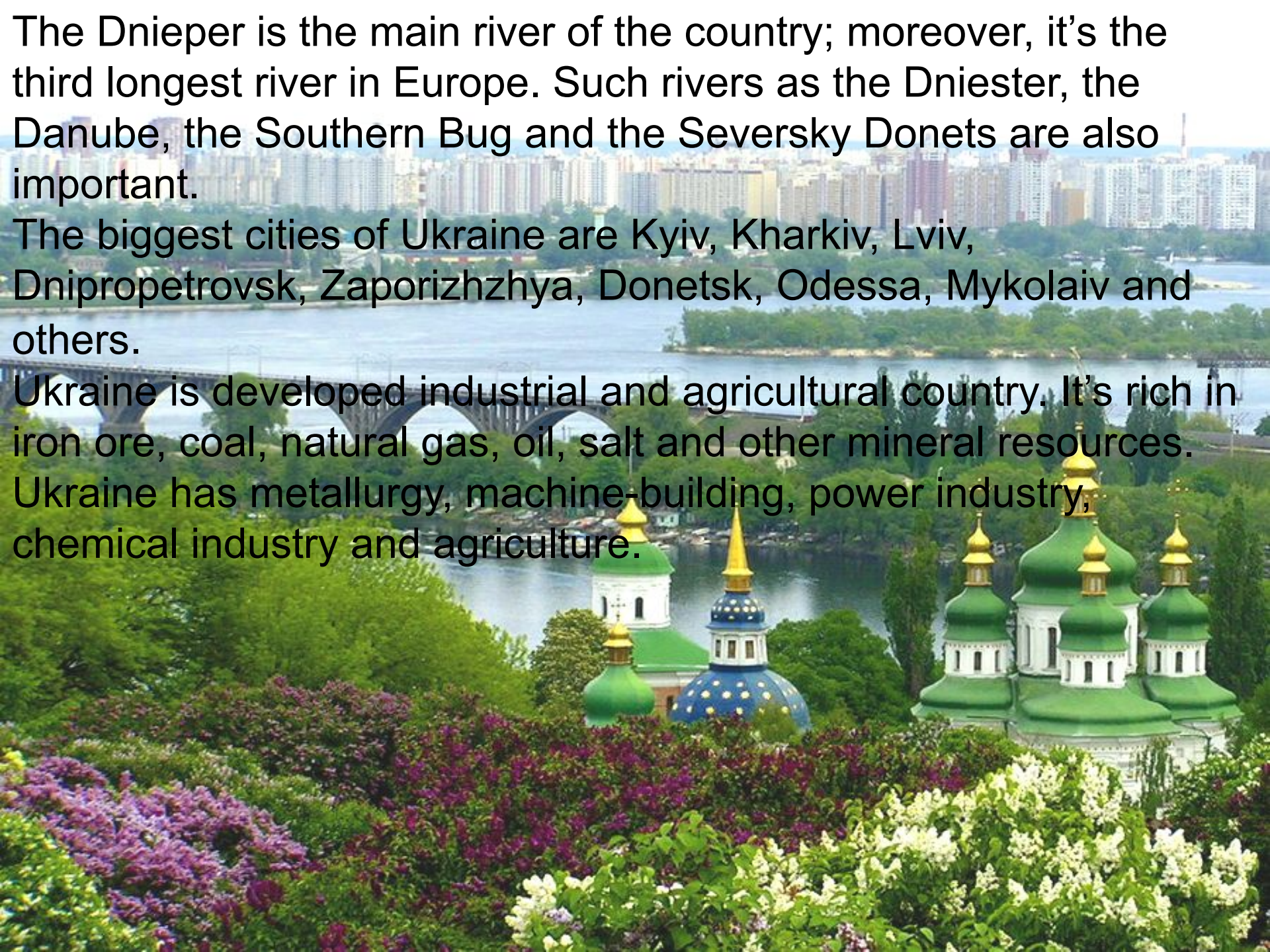

Ukraine is developed industrial and agricultural country. It's rich in iron ore, coal, natural gas, oil, salt and other mineral resources.

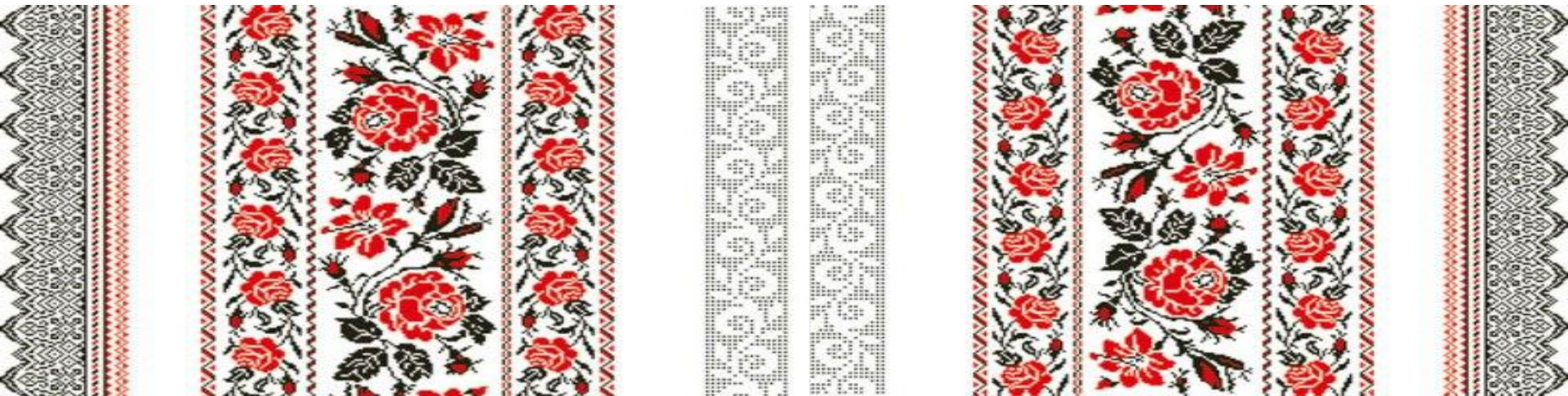
Ukraine has metallurgy, machine-building, power industry, chemical industry and agriculture.
