REINCARNATION DOES NOT

EXIST IN CHRISTIANITY

- No one, except for God, can decide if a person can be reborn
- There is no such thing as predetermination in Christianity
- Christianity gives a chance to rethink your views on life; reincarnation takes that away
- You can't have a "trade deal" with God



MASHA

Reincarnation does not exist in Islam

- there is no prospect for the reincarnation of a human being into a different body or being.
- during the early history of Islam, some of the Caliphs persecuted all reincarnation-believing people to the point of extinction in Mesopotamia and Persia.
- the idea of reincarnation is considered to be unhelpful to the spiritual seeker.
- the changing of a person's emotional state is described as “rebirth” or reincarnation, but this should not be confused with the physical death and rebirth.



REINCARNATION DOES NOT EXIST IN CONFUCIANISM

- Life is dedicated to admiring nature's beauty, there is no place for something 'abstract' like reincarnation and afterlife.

Reincarnation does not exist in *Zoroastrianism*



- The soul, or a person's being, is a godly thing.
- After a soul is guided by angels to the spiritual world, it faces judgment and finds its place in the afterlife.
- Zoroastrians believe that in the spiritual world all their ancestors wait and watch over the living.
- You get what you give out. If you live a good life, you'll face an even better life after death. If you make poor decisions, you'll face consequences.
