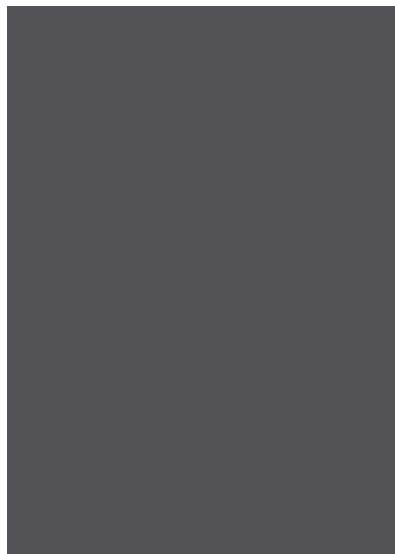


Peregrine

Peregrine falcon is a predatory bird, lives everywhere except Antarctica.

In length it reaches 40-50 cm, and weighs 0.6-1.3 kg, females in peregrine are larger than males.

The body is streamlined. Chest with well developed musculature.





Peregrine falcon is the fastest bird. Has the highest speed among all living animals on the planet

In a horizontal flight the peregrine falcon develops a speed of no more than 100-110 km / h. In the fall his body cuts the air at a speed of 240-300 km / h! This is the highest speed, which is fixed among all living beings.

The favorite prey of Peregrine Falcons - birds of medium size: pigeons, gulls, sandpipers.

The main weapon of peregrine is large legs with strong clawed fingers.



Peregrine falcons live alone, in the nesting period they are kept in pairs.

Peregrine Falcons are monogamous birds, their pairs are preserved for life.
