What is etiquette?

- The word 'etiquette' comes from a French word 'ticket'.
- Etiquette is a set of rules.
- Etiquette means the formal rules of correct and polite behaviour.
- Each society has its own etiquette. It's important to follow the rules.

- In some cultures people **hug** each other

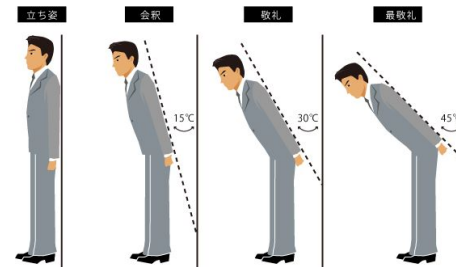


Bowing

It is good manners to greet a person





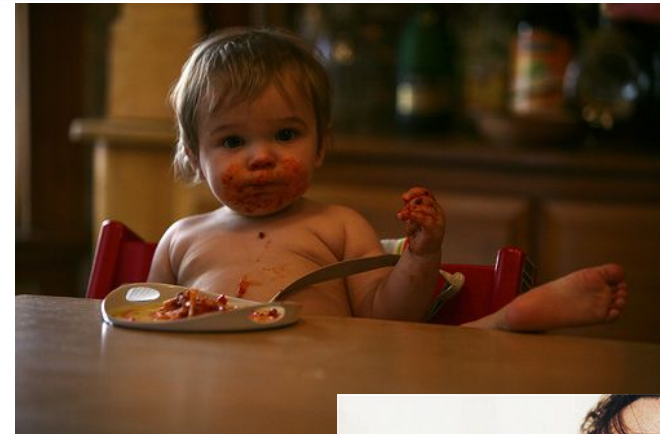
