Contract

All the conditions of the international contract are grouped into separate sections and are arranged in a specific sequence. According to the practice, these sections are usually referred to as "articles" and are numbered in order.

International contract can be divided into the following parts:

1. Preamble (introduction);
2. The main part , which include:
 - *subject of contract;*
 - *the price and value of the contract;*
 - *conditions of payment;*
 - *delivery conditions;*
 - *conditions of acceptance;*

Parts of contract:

3. Enforcement of the obligations and responsibilities of the parties:
 - *conditions of acceptance of the goods / services;*
 - *Force Majeure;*
 - *Arbitration (adjudication);*
 - *sanctions*
4. Other terms and conditions.
5. Requisites of the 2 sides.



The above structure is *not mandatory*.

At the moment, neither in the *Republic of Kazakhstan* legislation or *international level* there is no document that would strictly fixed the structure and content of the contract. There are only recommendations on drawing up contracts.
