### Contract

All the conditions of the international contract are grouped into separate sections and are arranged in a specific sequence. According to the practice, these sections are usually referred to as "articles" and are numbered in order.

# International contract can be divided into the following parts:

- 1. Preamble (introduction);
- 2. The main part, which include:
- subject of contract;
- the price and value of the contract;
- conditions of payment;
- delivery conditions;
- conditions of acceptance;

#### Parts of contract:

- 3. Enforcement of the obligations and responsibilities of the parties:
- conditions of acceptance of the goods / services;
- Force Majeure;
- Arbitration (adjudication);
- sanctions
- 4. Other terms and conditions.
- 5. Requisites of the 2 sides.

The above structure is *not mandatory*.

At the moment, neither in the *Republic of Kazakhstan* legislation or *international level* there is no document that would strictly fixed the structure and content of the contract. There are only recommendations on drawing up contracts.
