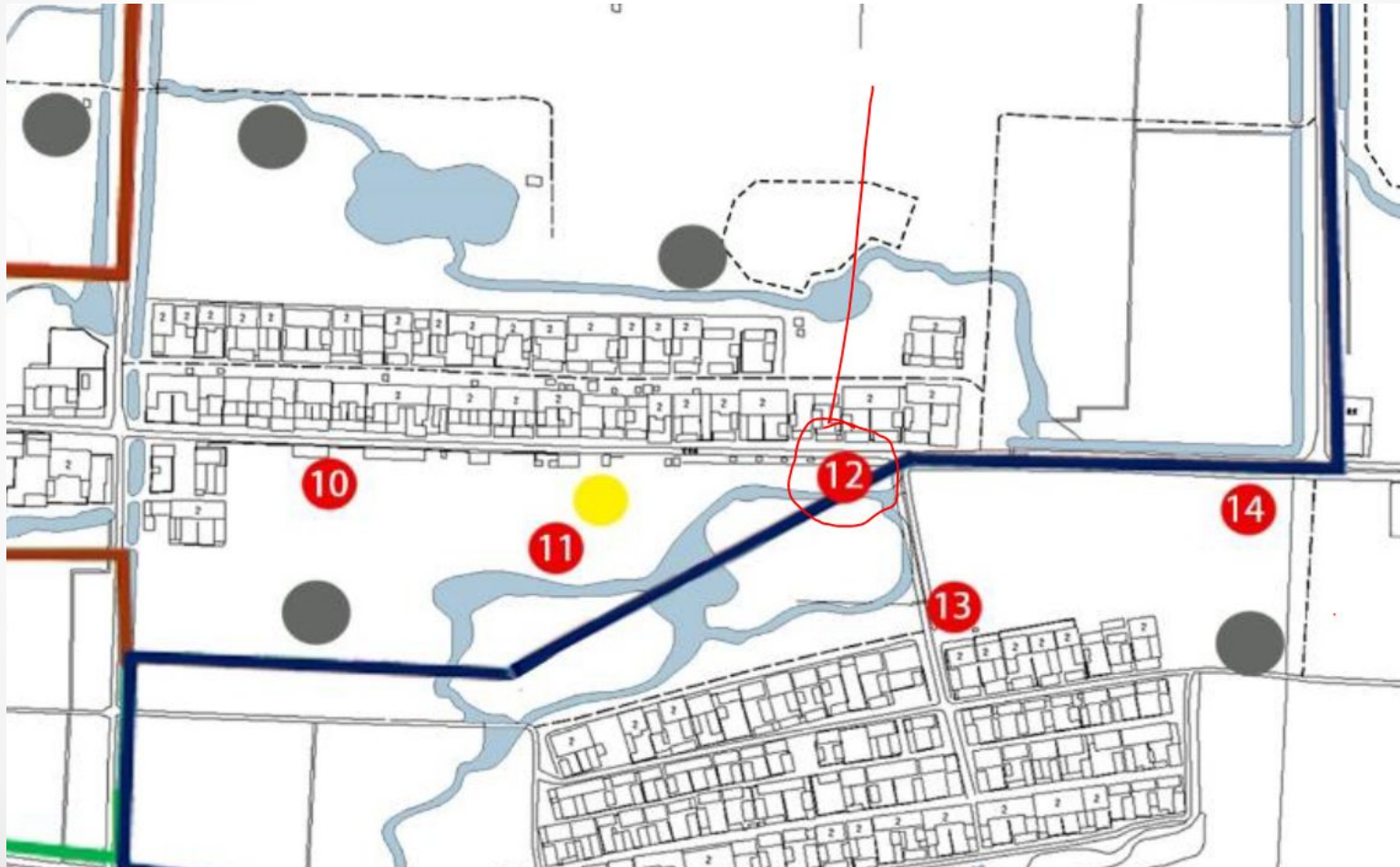

# Entertainment zones

For children safety, all zones must be located on the ground along the river. But **not on the river!**

1. Inground outdoor trampolines
2. Hammocks and swings zones
3. Rope walls for climbing
4. Lounge zone
5. Illuminated bamboo columns (Can be used as a night maze zone)

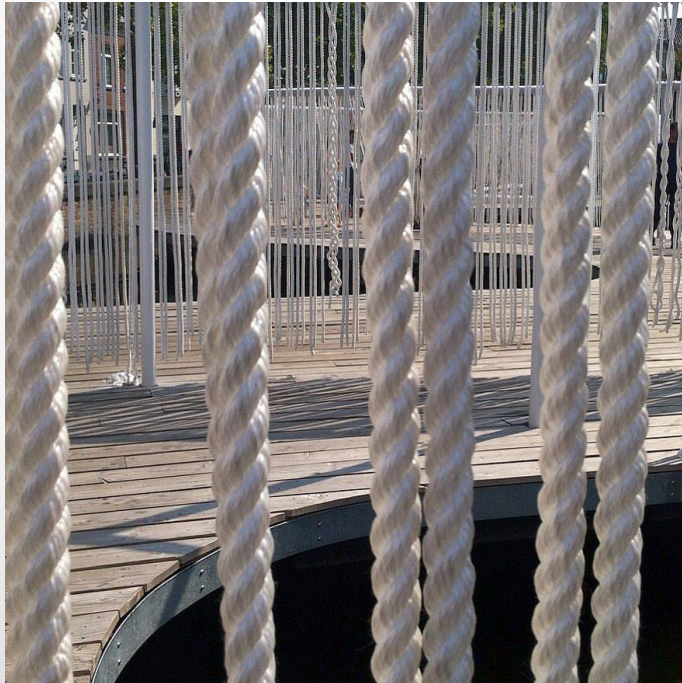
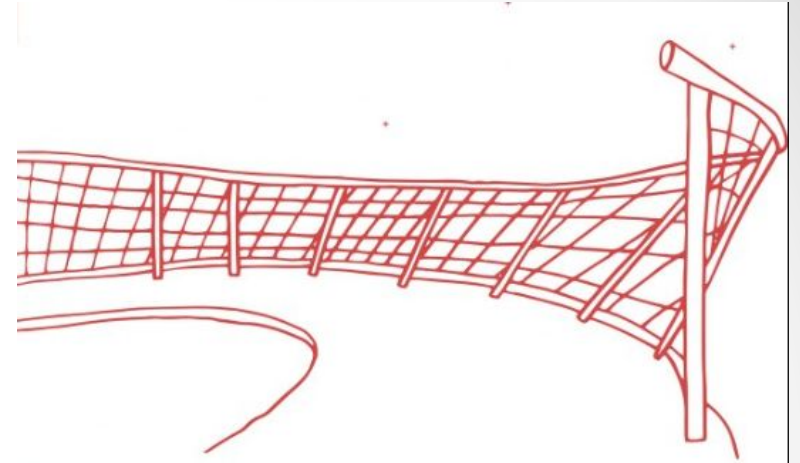
All made from bamboo
