


 Aboriginal settlers arrived on the continent from Southeast Asia about 40,000 years before the first Europeans began exploration in the 17th century.

The flag of Australia




Australia's coat of arms

Canberra is the capital of Australia. It is very young city.






Eureka Tower is a 297.3-metre (975 ft) skyscraper located in Melbourne, Victoria, Australia.


Great Barrier Reef








