

Three Degrees of Comparison

Superlative



Degree of Comparison

1. Adjectives of one syllable

- Adjectives of one syllable add -er and -est.
- Adjectives ending on 'e' just add -r and -st.
- Some adjectives double the final consonant.

Adjective	Comparative	Superlative	
small	smaller	smallest	
warm	warmer	warmest	
old	older	oldest	
nic e	nicer	nicest	
big	bigger	biggest	

Degree of Comparison

2. Adjectives of two syllables

- Some adjectives of two syllables add -er and -est.
- For adjectives ending in 'y' cut y then add -ier and -iest.
- Adjectives ending in -ful, -less, -ing, -ed use more and most.
- Some other adjectives of two syllables use more and most (modern, famous, normal, correct, ...).
