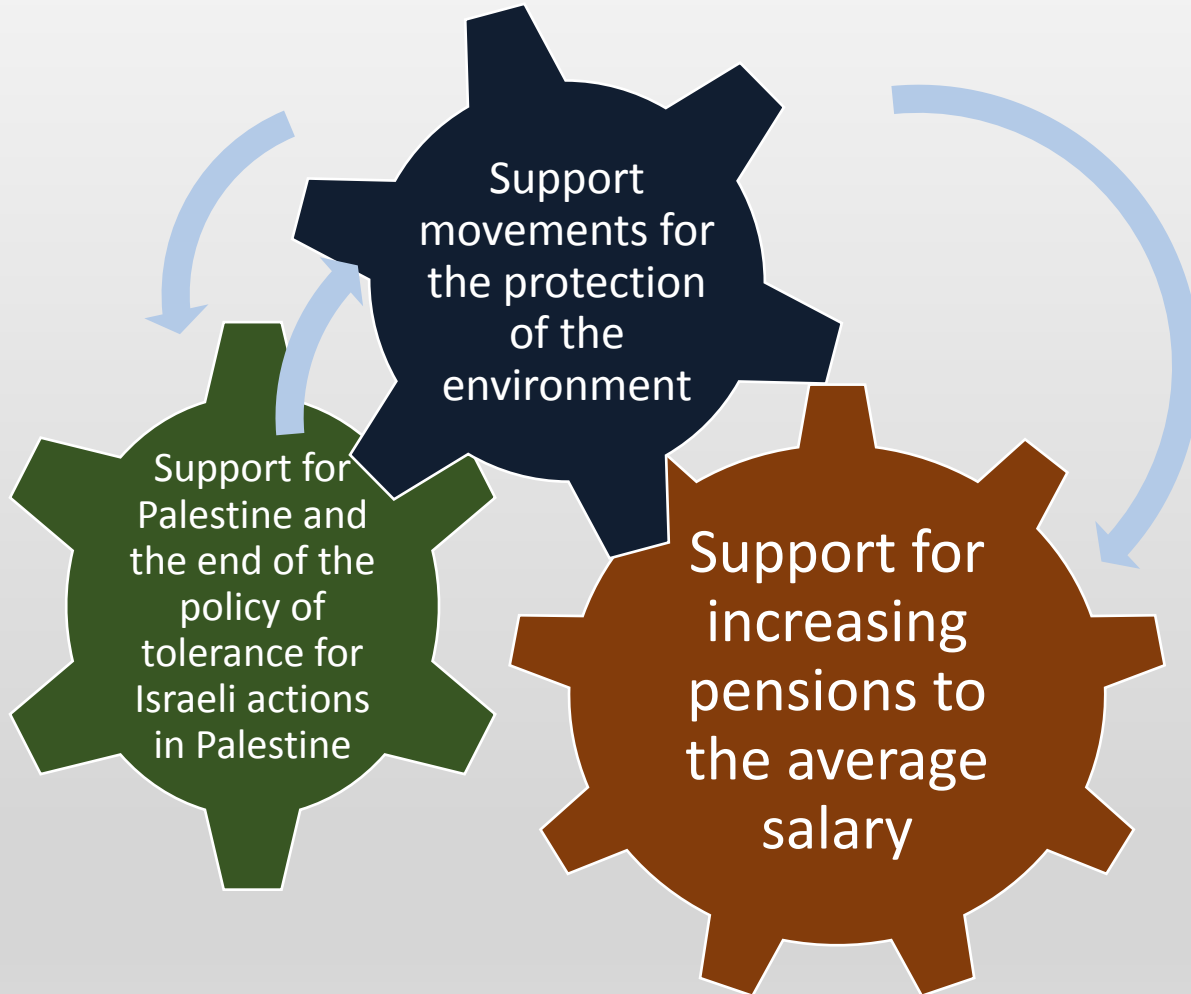

- 1 was a left-wing to far-left political party
- 2 one Member of Parliament (MP) in the House of Commons
- 3 nineteen councillors in local government
- 4 established in London by Salma Yaqoob and George Monbiot in 2004
- 5 Respect gradually lost its council seats and it deregistered with the Electoral Commission in 2016.

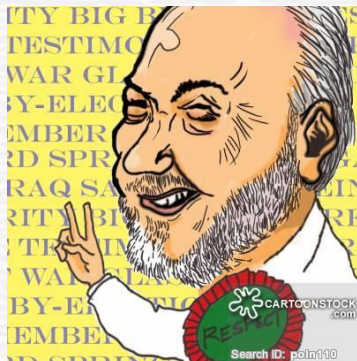
