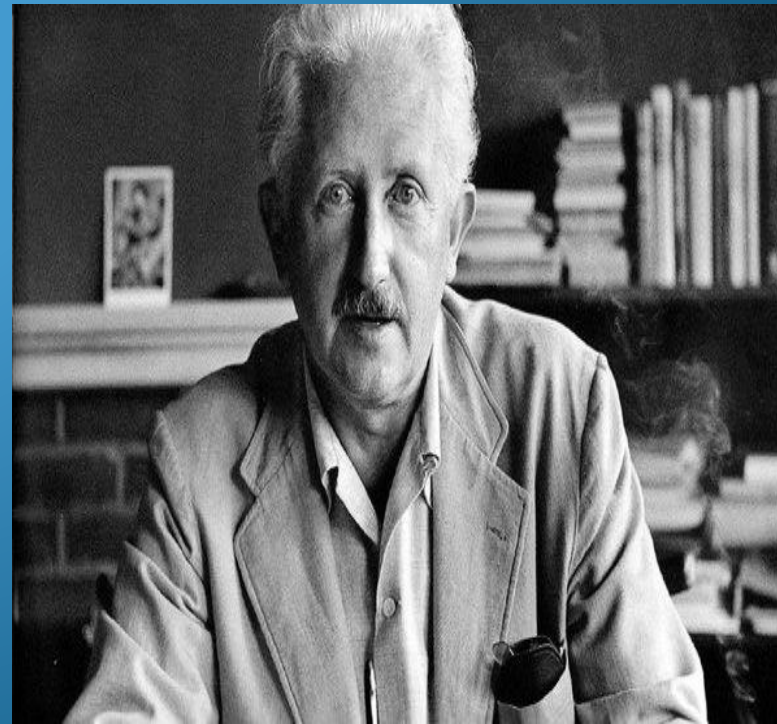
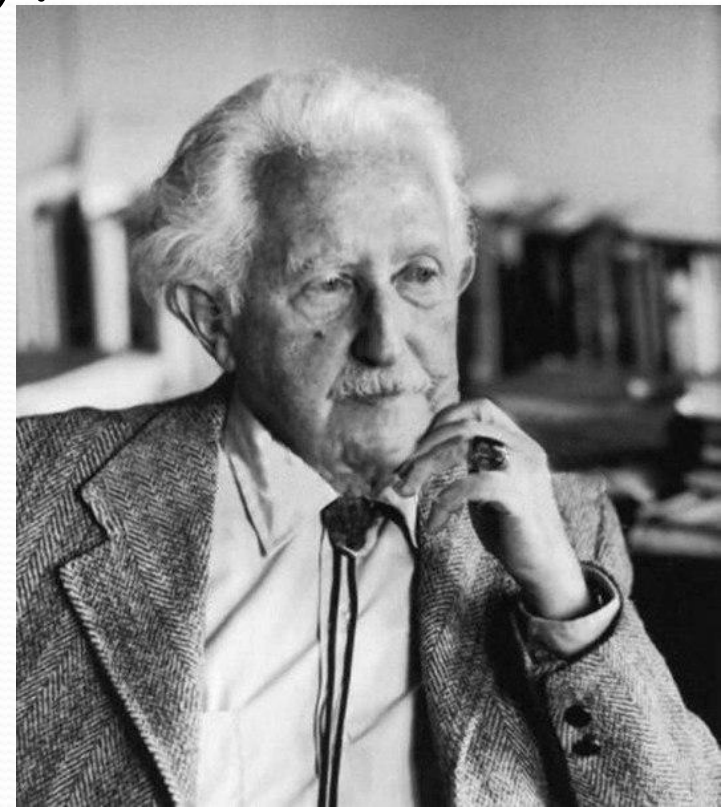

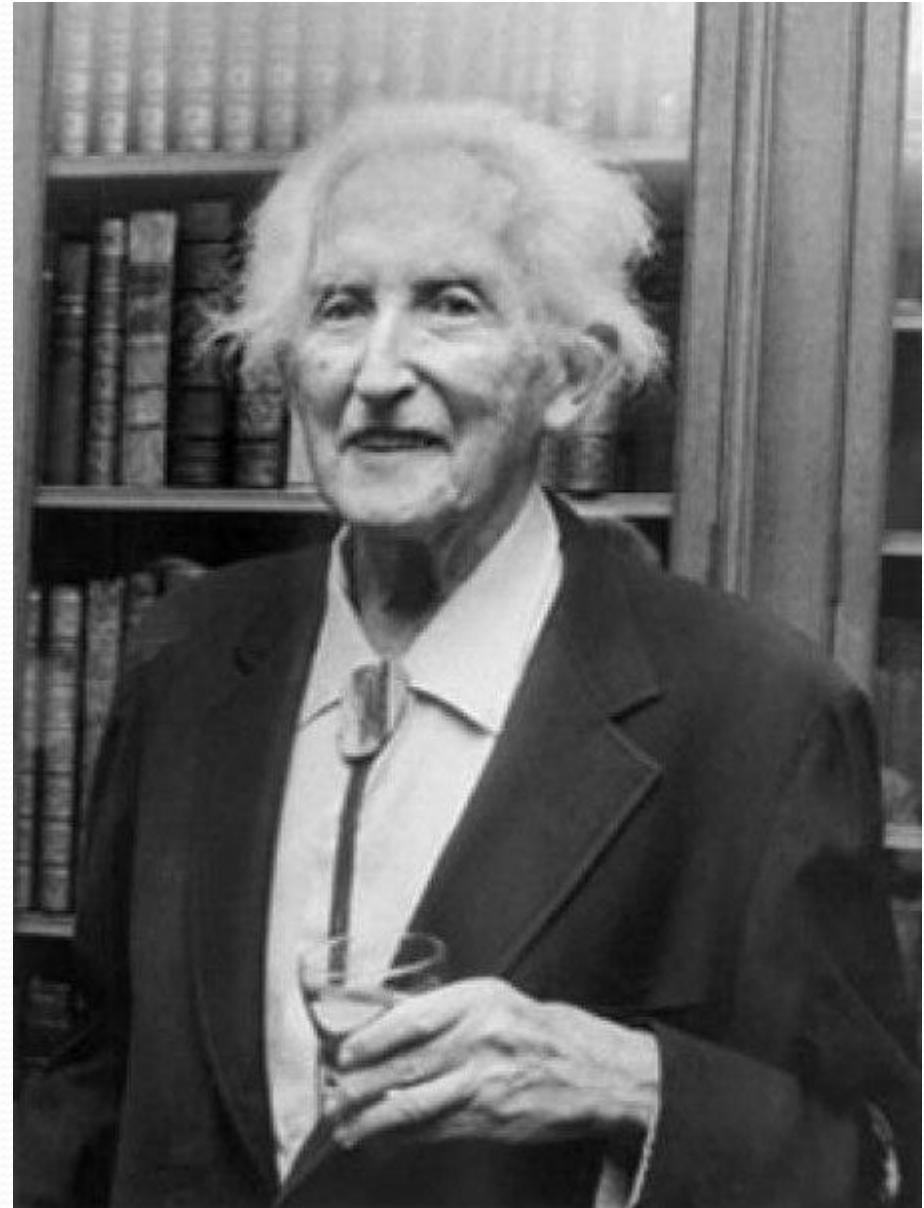
Erik Erikson was born in 1902 in Germany. He was raised by his mother and stepfather, who worked as a pediatrician. In youth Erikson studied art and traveled to Europe, dreaming of becoming an artist. Joan Serson, future wife Erikson studied at the analyst and introduced him to psychoanalysis (later he became a psychoanalyst, and she - the artist) .





- Erickson worked as a children's analyst and taught at Garvarde. On was admitted to the Harvard Psychological Clinic under the direction of Henry Murray and was the author of dramatic test. At different stages of his career, he has collaborated with the Institute of Human Relations.

- He conducted anthropological studies and observed features of personal development in an environment of two American Indian kultur. Erikson considered himself a Freudian, he offered a lot of theoretical innovation, emphasizes the role of social factors in the development of the ego. The most notable is its theoretical position on the development of the ego throughout life.



- Erickson died in a nursing home. May 12, 1994, at the age of 91.
