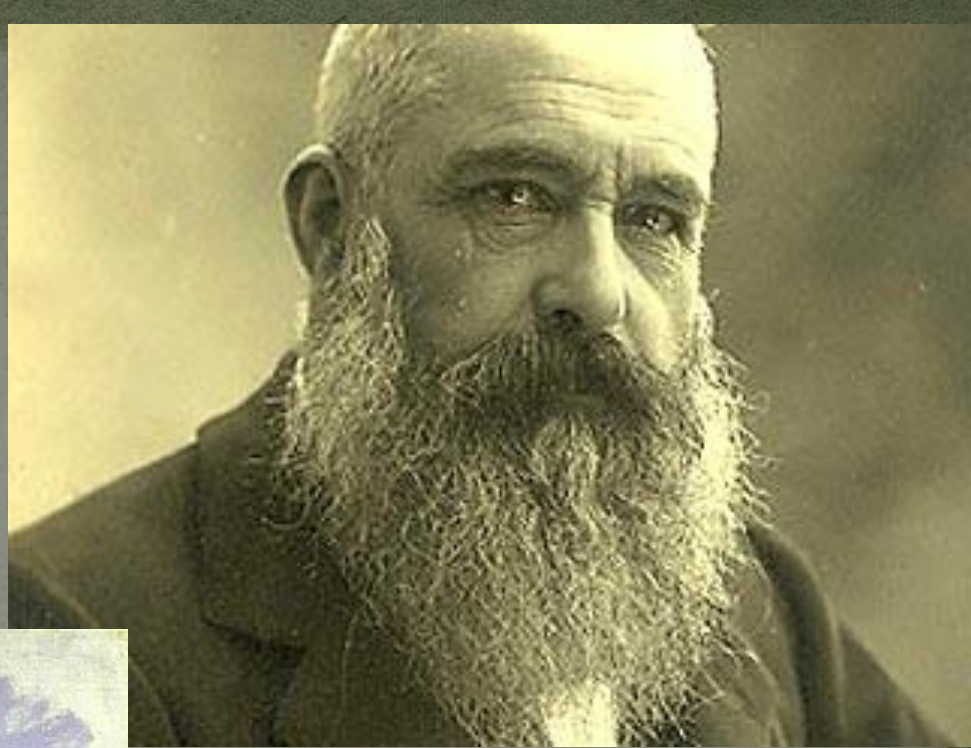
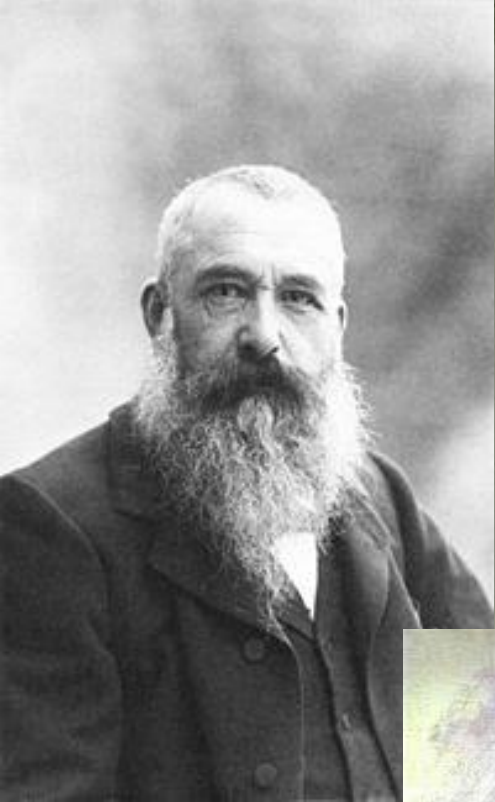


Oscar Claude Monet

French painter, one of the founders of Impressionism



- Claude Oscar Monet was born on November 14, 1840 in Paris
- His father wanted to become a grocer Claude and joined the family business, but a son from childhood fond of the arts, particularly pleased drew cartoons. On the coast of Normandy.

- Early paintings Monet marked freshness and rich flavor. In later works, such as "Impressions. Sunrise" Monet admired transmission subjective, random, fleeting impressions, self-contained experiments in color decomposition. The best works of Monet belong to the world heritage art.

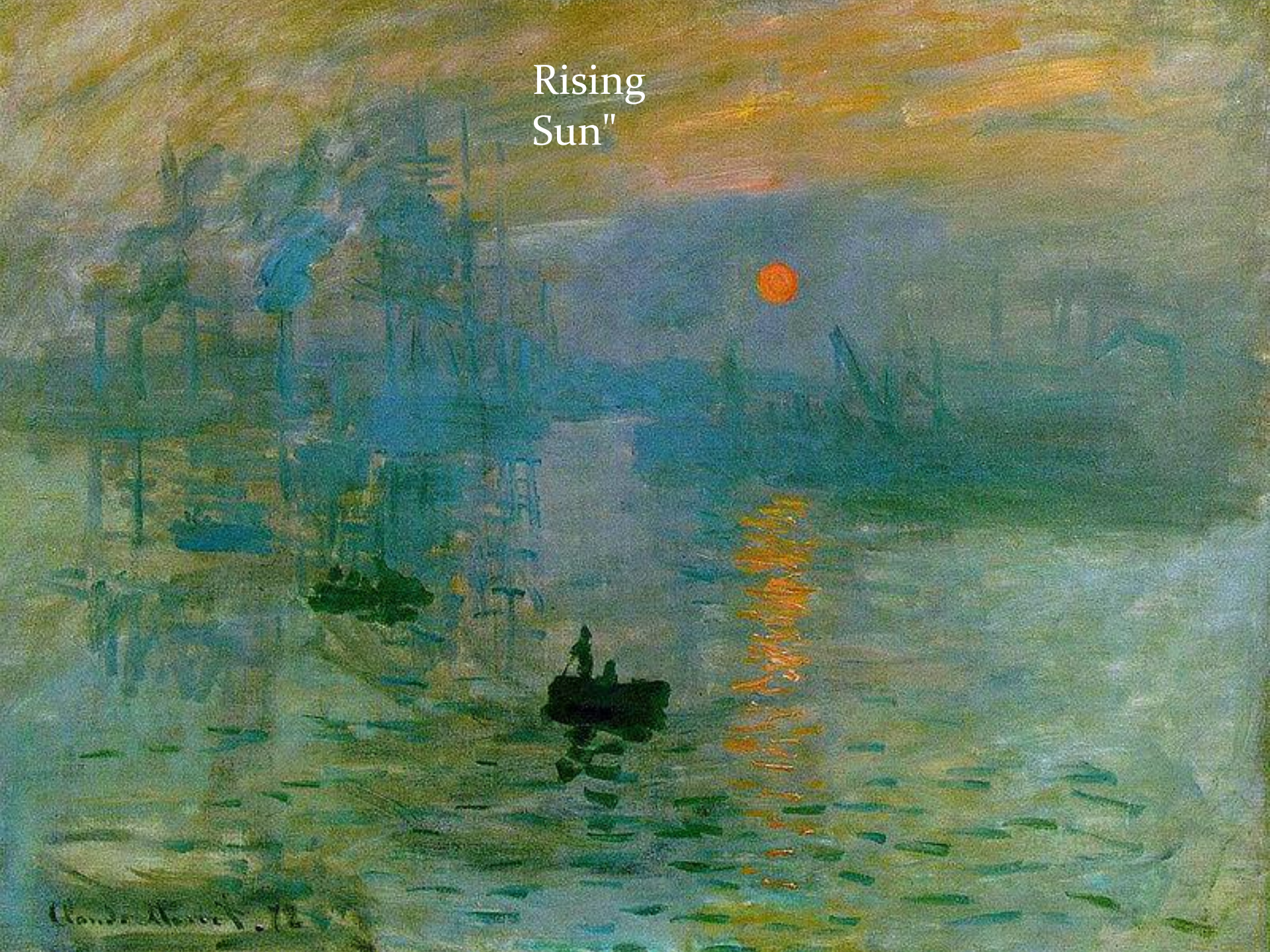
