


Hollywood

Times Square


Times Square is a square in the center of Manhattan, which is one of the most visited attractions in the world. It has many Broadway

Alcatraz is a prison for dangerous criminals, now turned into a museum. The legendary image of Alcatraz, reproduced in many films annually attracts millions of visitors.




The Empire State Building
