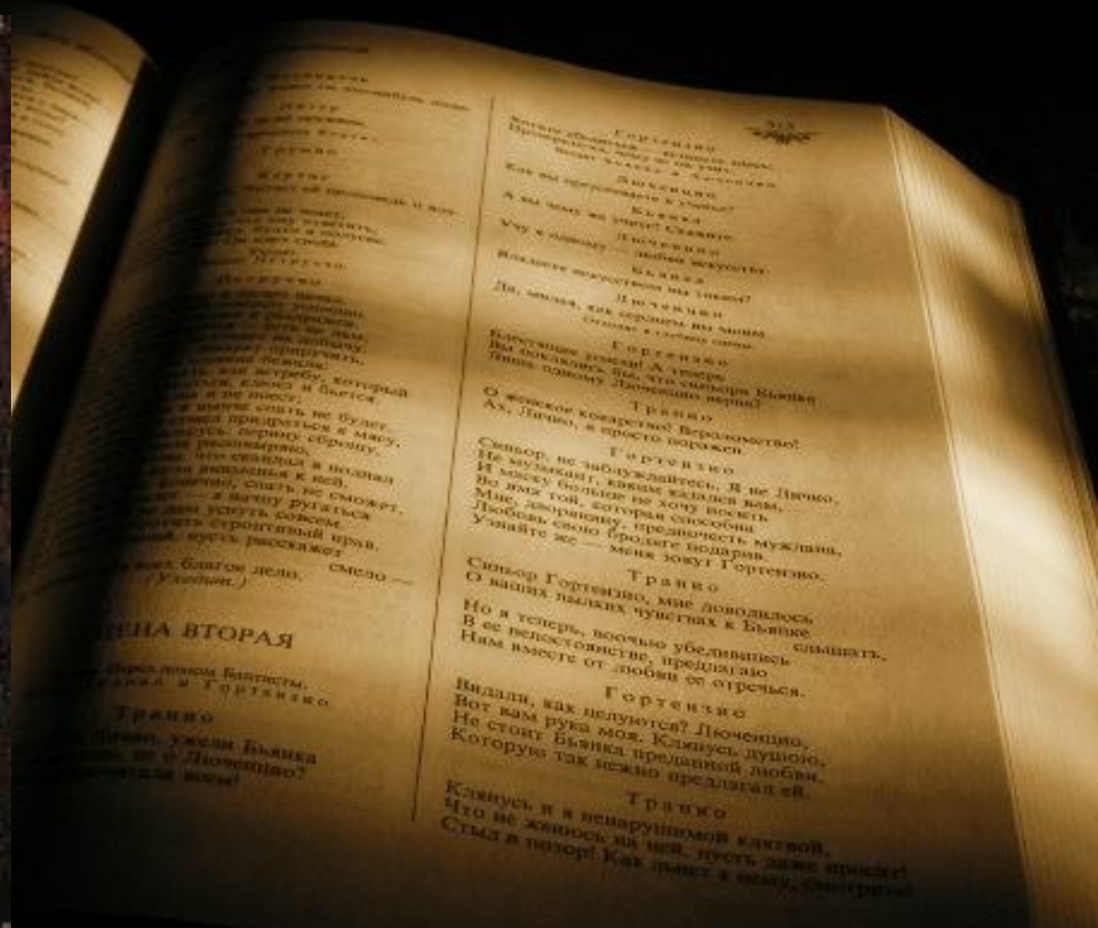

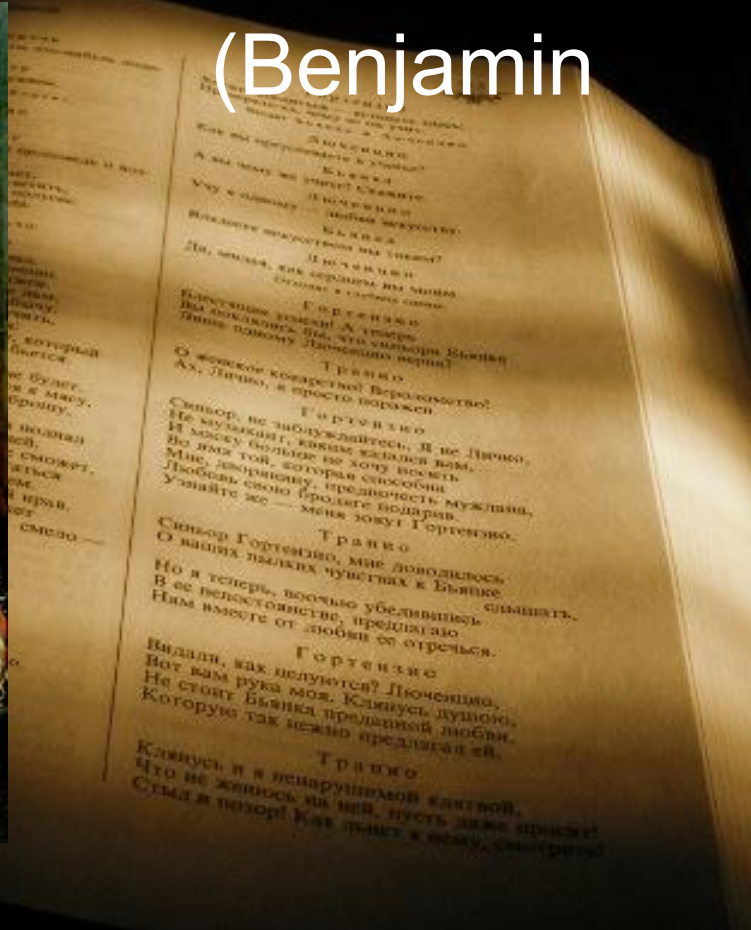

he was eighteen.

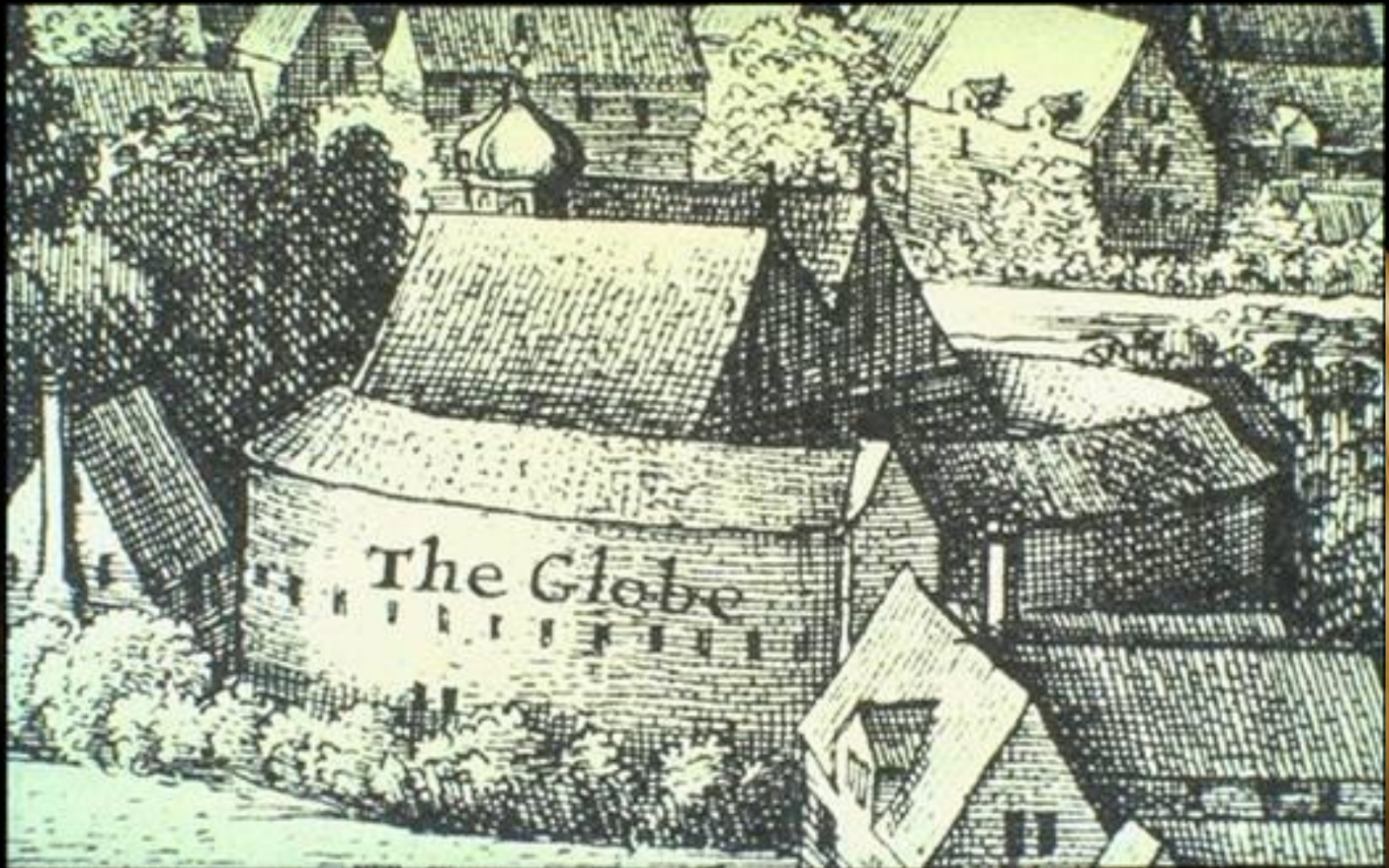

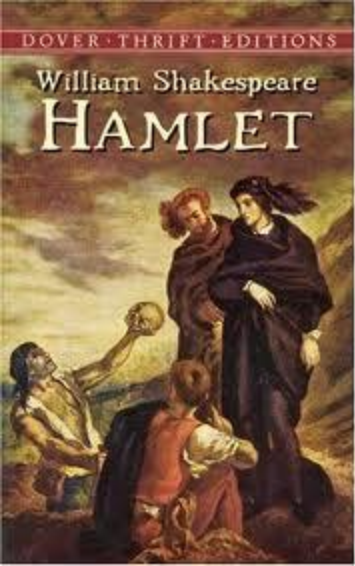

The Globe of Shakespeare's times.

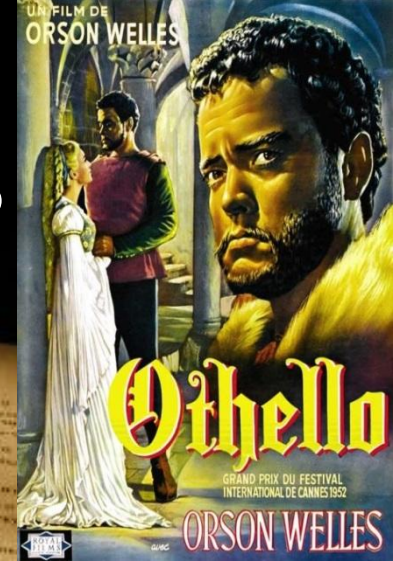
New Globe theatre.
