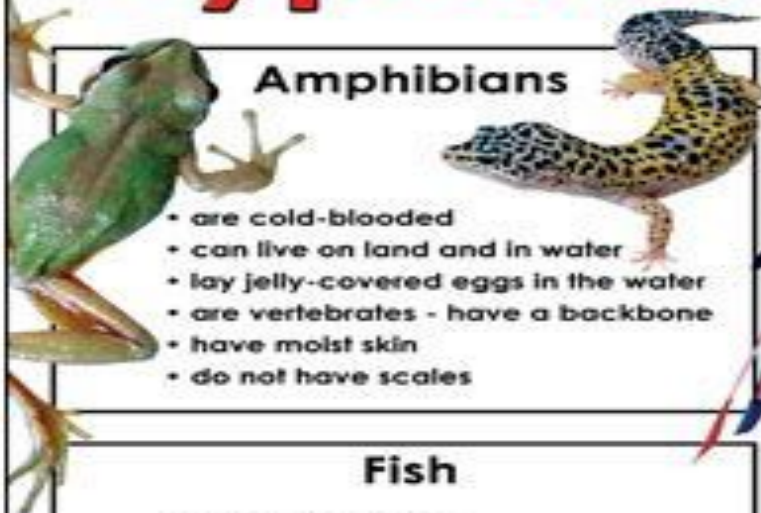

# Types of Animals

## Amphibians



- are cold-blooded
- can live on land and in water
- lay jelly-covered eggs in the water
- are vertebrates - have a backbone
- have moist skin
- do not have scales

## Birds



- are animals with feathers
- have two legs and two wings
- have a beak or a bill
- lay eggs
- are warm-blooded

## Fish



- are cold blooded
- lay eggs
- are covered with scales
- have fins not legs
- live in water and breathe through gills

## Insects



- have six legs
- are made up of 3 parts - head, thorax and abdomen
- have a pair of antennae
- have one or two pairs of wings
- are cold-blooded
- lay many eggs

## Mammals



- have fur or hair
- babies drink milk from their mother's bodies
- are vertebrates - have a backbone
- have four limbs
- breathe air through their lungs
- are warm-blooded

## Reptiles



- have dry, scaly skin
- have short legs or no legs at all
- breathe air through their lungs
- are cold-blooded
- are vertebrates - have a backbone
- lay many eggs

## **LEOPARD**

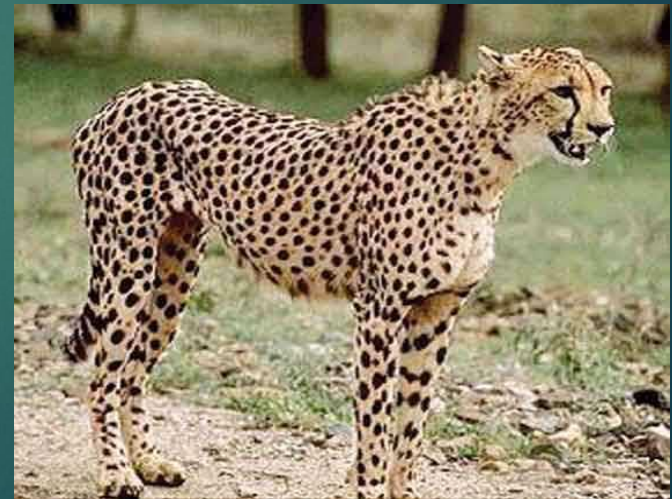
Has plain rosettes with no central spot in the middle; and more densely packed

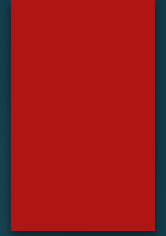

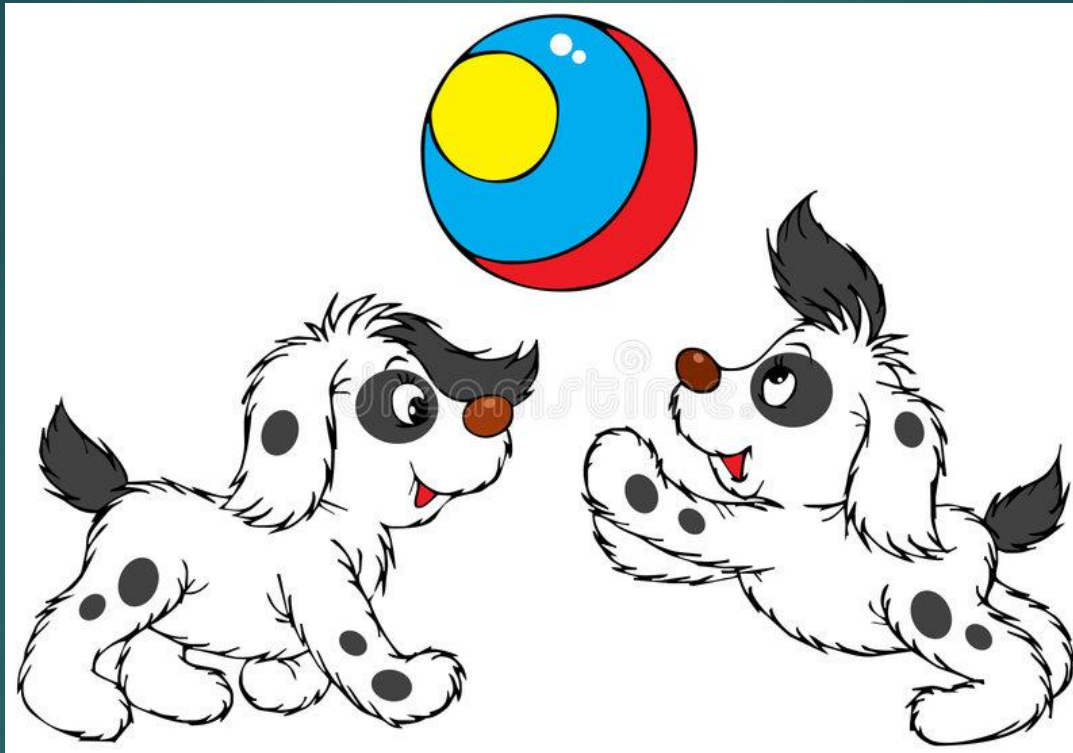
