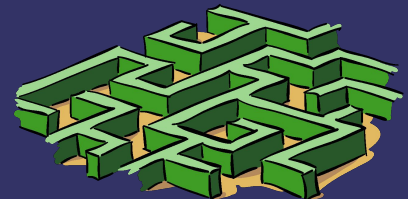


Schools in England and Russia.



School in England and Russian school.(differences)

- In England, compulsory education begins at the age of 5. In this country, the education system is 13 years old. Children up to 5 years old can attend kindergartens and preparatory groups. From 5 to 11 years (in many private schools up to 13 years), children attend primary school.
- In Russia, school starts at the age of 6-7 and ends at the age of 16-17. Education in Russia is carried out in large classes (25-30 people), as a result, not all students receive enough attention from teachers.

Pros and cons of studying at an English school.
