

Mountain Everest



Geology

- ▶ Situated in the Himalayas , in the ridge Mahalangur Himal (the part called Khumbu Himal -) . South summit (8760 m) lies on the border of Nepal and Tibet Autonomous Region (China) , North (main) summit (8848 m) is located on the territory of China .

- ▶ **Climate**

At the top of Chomolungma are strong winds blowing with a speed up to 55 m / s . The air temperature is lowered at night to -60°C .



Animals

- ▶ Even high in the sky , where the thin air is very difficult to breathe , we can not hide from the spiders, more commonly known as Himalayan jumping spider , hiding in cracks and corners of the slopes of Everest , so they are among the creatures living at the highest altitudes in the world .
