Comparative adjectives

- Elsa is older than Anna
- Anna is younger than Elsa
- Elsa has longer hair than Anna
- Elsa is taller than Anna

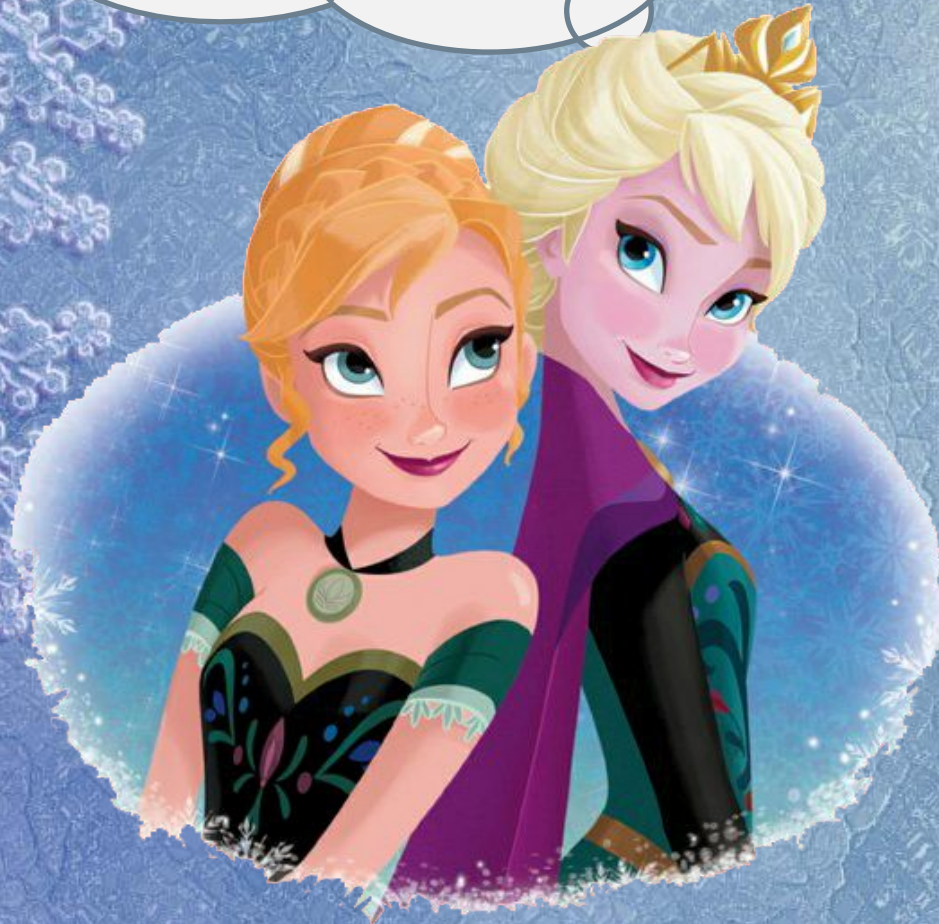
! Adjective + -er



Exceptions

- Adjectives ending in **-e = +r** □
nice □ nicer
- Adjectives ending in **-y = -y and +ier** □
happy □ happier
- Adjectives ending in **vowel + consonant = double the consonant +er** □
big □ bigger
- Longer adjectives (2 or more syllables) = **more + adjective** □
Difficult □ more difficult

Superlative adjectives

- Elsa is the smartest girl in town.
- Anna is the sweetest sister there is.
- Olaf is the funniest snowman ever.
- Kristoff is the bravest.

! Adjective + -est

Exceptions

- Adjectives ending in **-e = +st** □
nice □ nicest
- Adjectives ending in **-y = -y and +iest** □
happy □ happiest
- Adjectives ending in **vowel + consonant = double the consonant +est** □
big □ biggest
- Longer adjectives (2 or more syllables) =
most + adjective □
Difficult □ most difficult

Irregular adjectives

Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
Good	Better	Best
Bad	Worse	Worst
Far	Further	Furthest
Many	More	Most
