Today 18,000 students studied in Cambridge

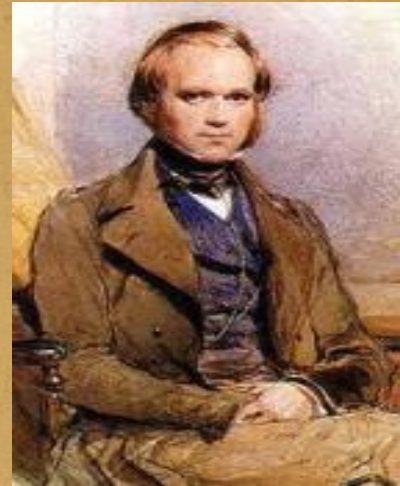
