Исчисляемые и неисчисляемые существительные употребляются с разными количественными местоимениями

С исчисляемыми существительными мы используем many-много a lot of -много some-несколько a few- немного few-мало Haпpumep: many sweets, some sweets, a few sweets, few sweets

С неисчисляемыми существительными мы используем much-много a lot of -много some-немного a little- немного little-мало Haпример: much milk, some milk, a little milk, little milk

В вопросительных предложениях мы используем any-какие-нибудь /much /many В отрицательных предложениях мы используем

not any-никакие /not much /not many
