We go by boat and we go by plane.

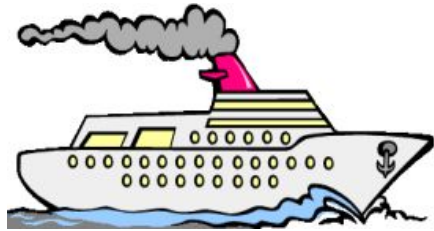
We go by ship, on foot, by air.
