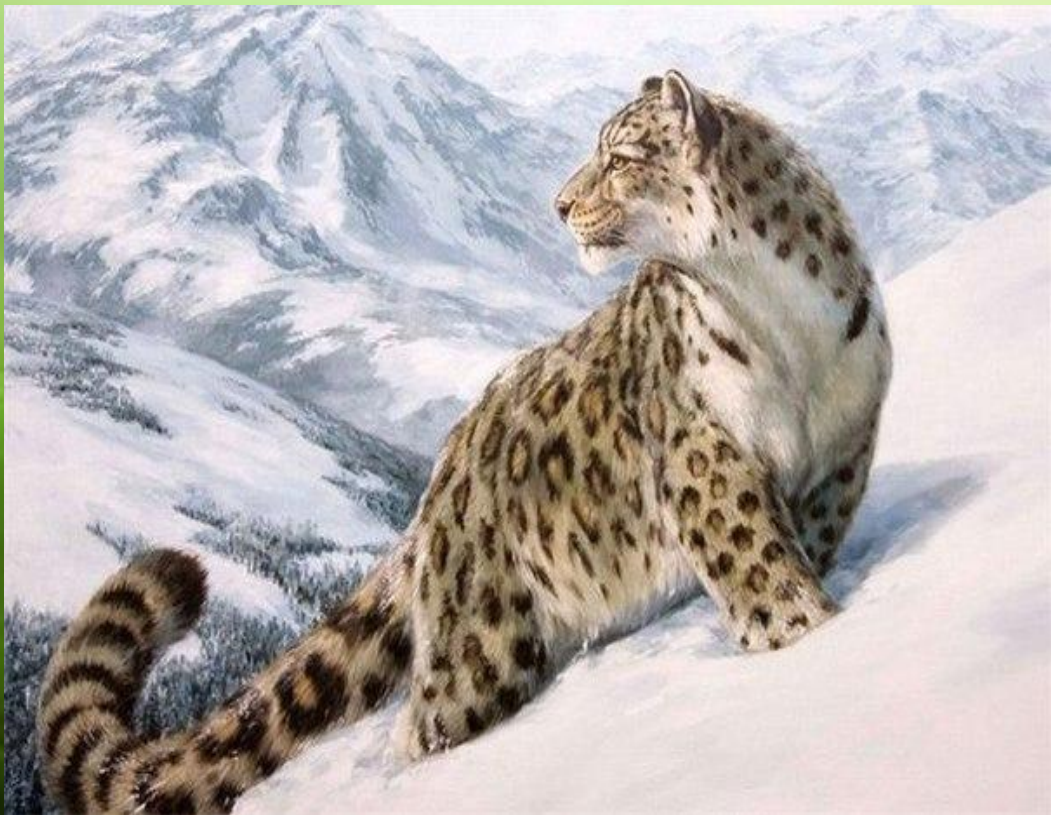
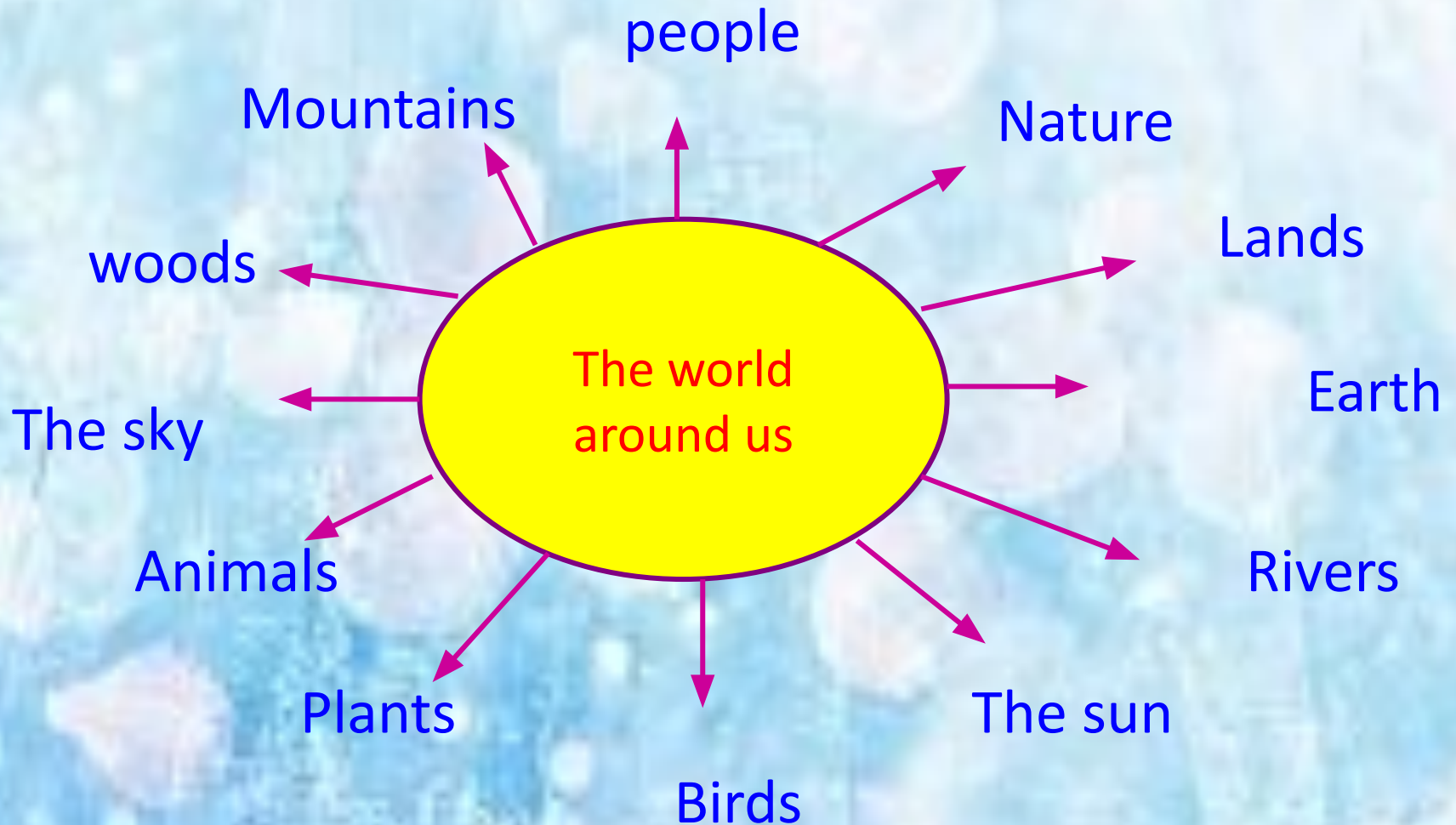




Diagram “The world around us”

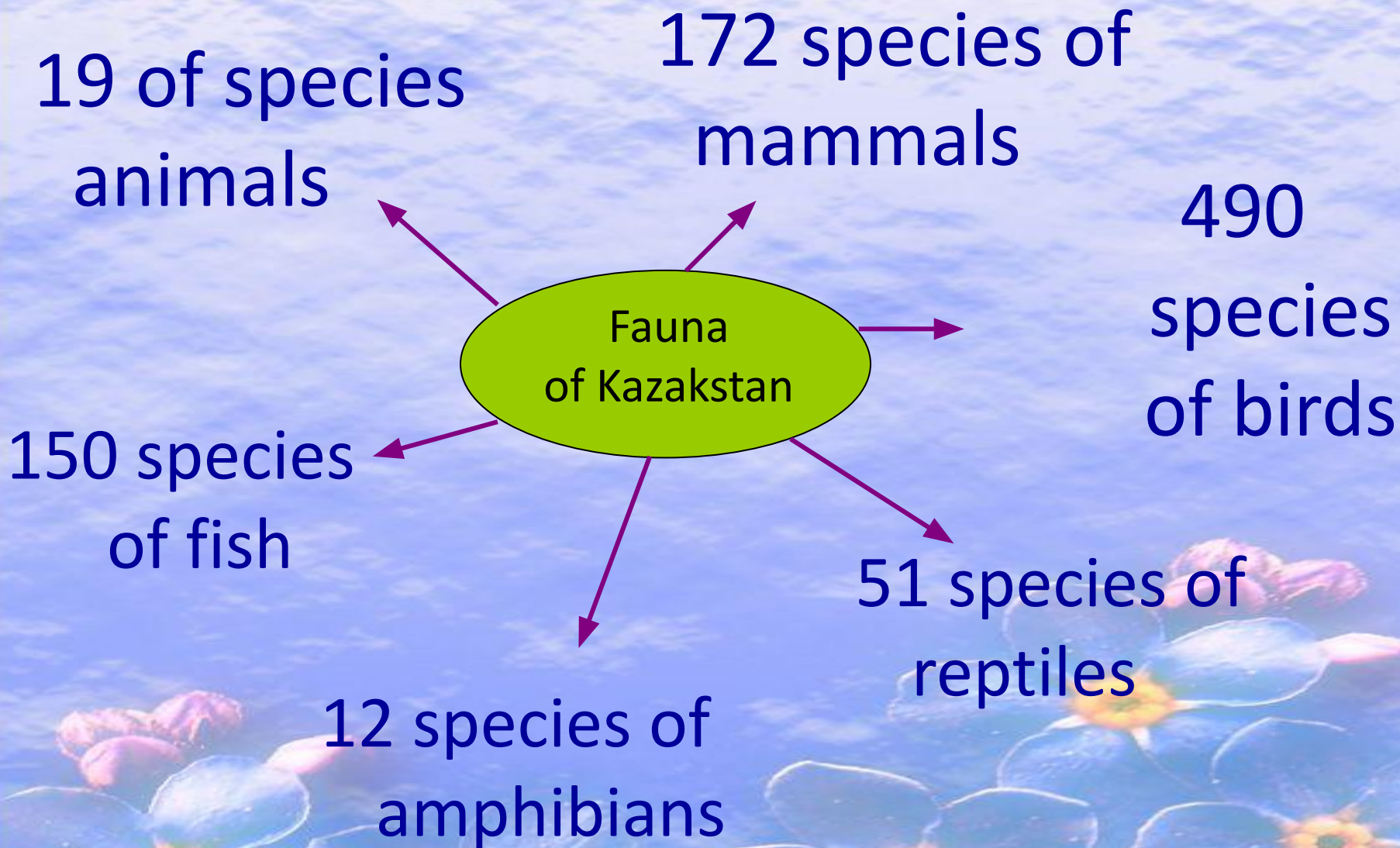

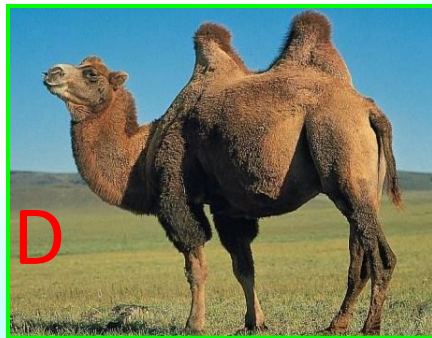

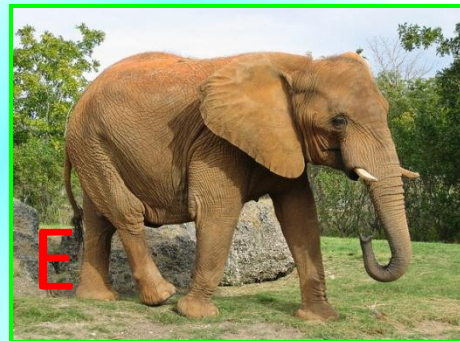
