# Objectives

By the end of this lecture students will be able:

- to distinguish the stages of writing activities
- to design pre-writing and post-writing activities.

### Self-Reflection

- How did you feel when were to write smth. at school or at the university?
- What do you think a person should know when writing in a foreign language?
  - the writing code, spelling, punctuation, grammar, lexis, linking words, background knowledge, text type, the aim, the audience, the size.

  - the aim (e.g. to remind of, to inform)
  - the audience (the person who read it)


Write a paragraph to describe Mary Shelley from the point of view of her husband. Mary's daughter will read it.

#### 6.8: Task - Virtual observation

Aim - by the end of the lesson, learners will be able to:

- describe themselves briefly
- write a personal profile in order to find an e-pal

#### Length - 1 hour

Lesson Stage and timing	Aim	Procedure	Interaction
<b>Lead in</b> 5 mins	To create interest in the topic – e-pals	Tell a short story about epals.	Whole class
Game 10 mins	To review vocabulary about hobbies in preparation for later writing activity	Mime a hobby, learners guess. Learners take it in turns to come to the front of the class, pick a card and mime the hobby that is on it. The rest of the class guess. Display cards on the board as a reference for writing later on.	Whole class
Brainstorming 10 mins	To ensure learners know the aim of the lesson To establish the content of a personal profile To create a reason for reading the model text	Write lesson objectives on board. Ask questions to check understanding. Pairs think of components of a personal profile. Write a mind map on the board using learners' ideas.	Pairs > whole class
Reading 5 mins	To read for specific information To provide learners with a model text of a personal profile	Learners read the model text and compare the content with their ideas from the previous stage.	Individual
Writing 15 mins	To create a personal profile	Learners write their profile.	Individual
Feedback 15 mins	To give feedback on the content and language of learners' profiles	Learners present their personal profiles to the class. Other learners listen and ask questions. At the end of the activity, correct any common errors. Finally, review the lesson objectives.	Whole class

# Pre-Writing


- Choose one of the writing activities from the previous step. What would you do to prepare your learners for writing? Think about:
